Description	EFT Time Commitment
<b>1. CTU Attending</b>	26 weeks = .8
<b>2. NTU Attending</b>	26 weeks = .4
<b>3. Critical Care Attending (MICU, CCU, SICU)</b>	13 weeks = .8
<b>4. Specialty Inpatient Unit with limited off hour intake</b> (e.g. Rheumatology)	39 weeks = .6
<b>5. Rehab Inpatient Unit Attending</b>	39 weeks = .5
<b>6. Bone Marrow Transplant Unit</b>	19 weeks = .8
<b>7. Low Volume Subspecialty Consult Service</b> (non-procedural) e.g. Rehab, Clinical Allergy, Dermatology	39 weeks = .3
<b>8. High Volume Subspecialty Consult</b> (non-procedural) e.g. Endocrine, Card, Infectious Diseases	39 weeks = .6
<b>9. Subspecialty Consult Service</b> (procedural) e.g. Acute GI Bleed, Respiratory, Bronchoscopy, Echocardiography, Nephrology	39 weeks = .8
<b>10. Angiography</b>	1 day/week (46 weeks) = .2
<b>11. Angiography &amp; Call or Echocardiography &amp; Call</b>	1 day/week + call (46 weeks) = .25
<b>12. Ambulatory Care Clinics</b> (1/2 day per week)	(46 weeks) = .1
<b>13. Bed Doctor</b>	39 weeks = .3
<b>14. Renal Transplant Service</b> (includes 5 ½-day clinics)	39 weeks = .8
<b>15. EKG, EEG, EMG, Sleep Study Interpretation</b>	½ day/week = .1
<b>16. Central Dialysis Unit Attending</b>	30 weeks = .8 ½ day = .1

**EFT = Equivalent Full Time - (1.0 EFT = 50 hrs/week)**
