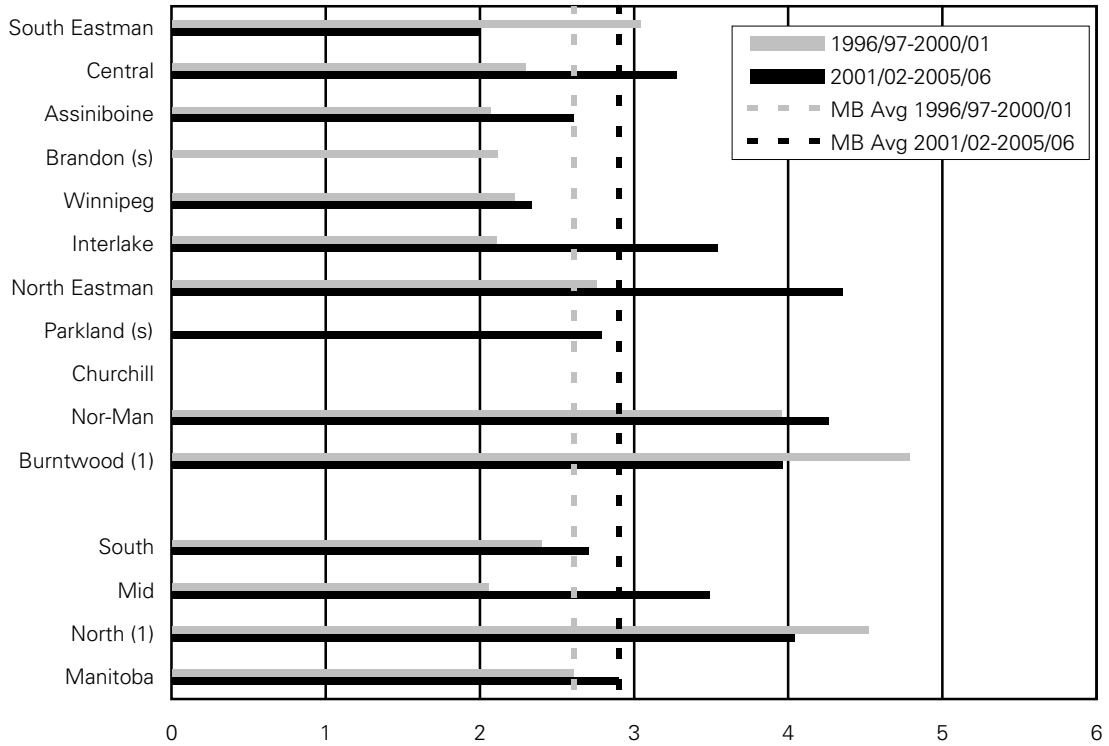


Figure A.3.102: Cleft Palate or Cleft Lip Rates by RHA

'2' indicates area's rate was statistically different from Manitoba average in second time period

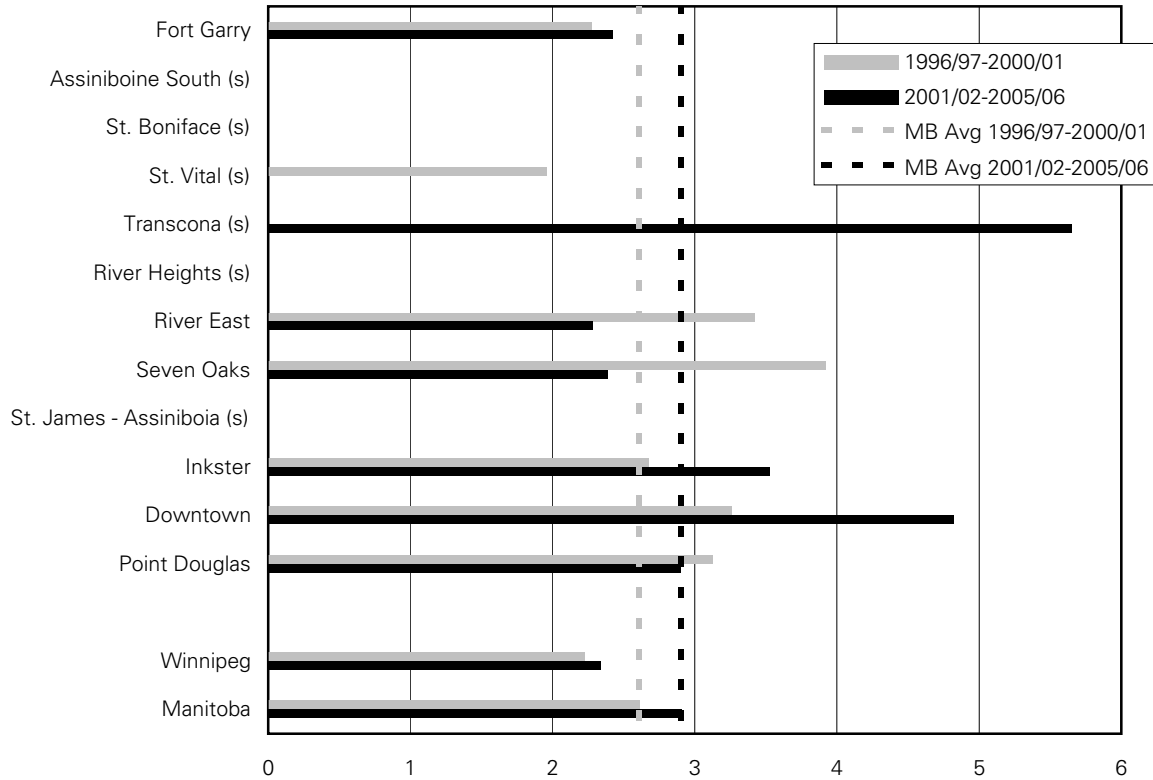

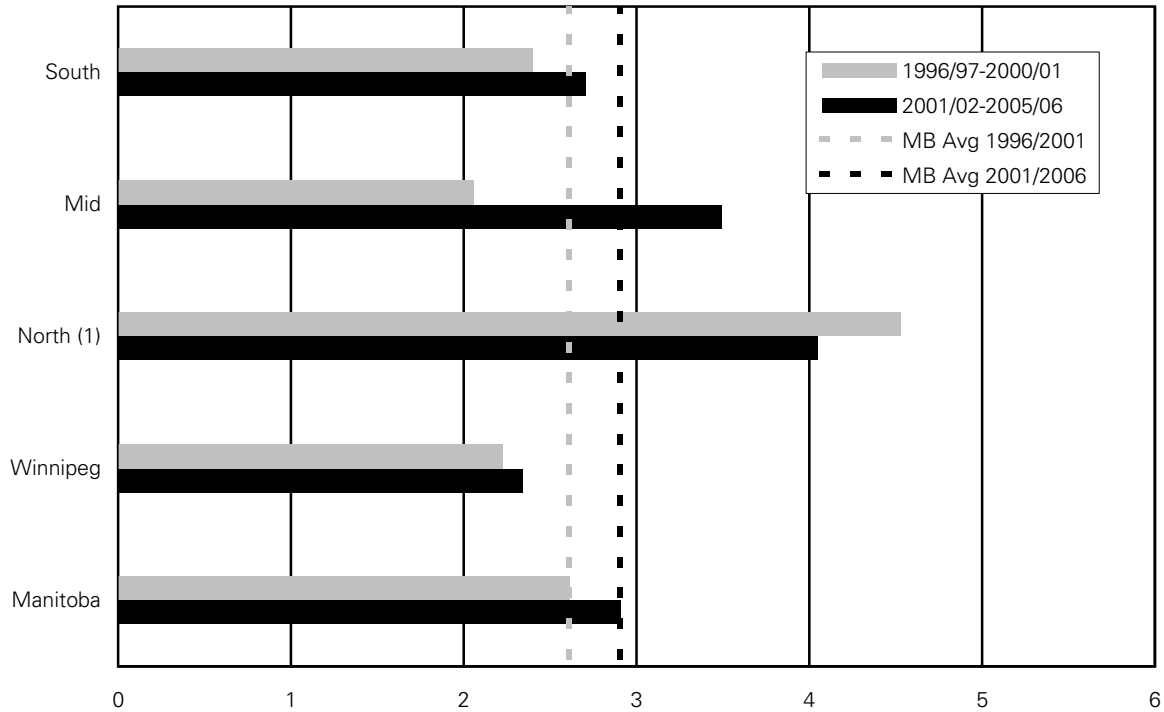
