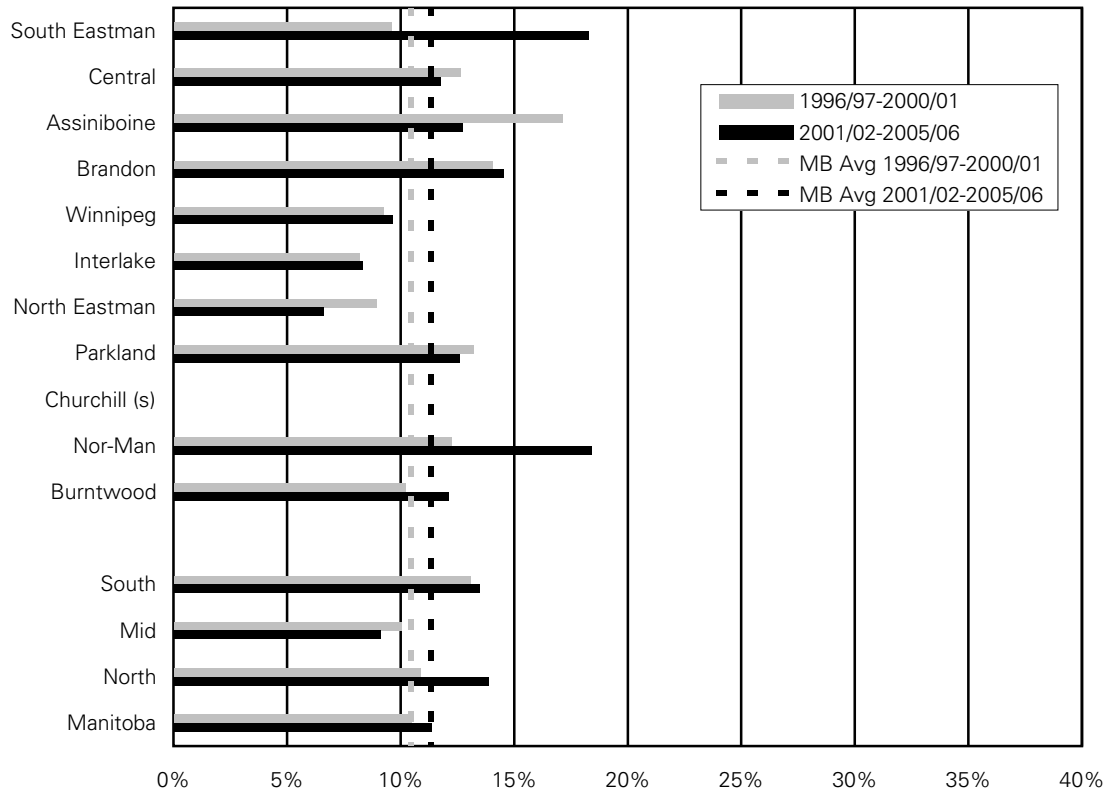


**Figure A.3.28: Caesarean Section Rate of Women Aged 0-19 by RHA**

Crude percent of deliveries

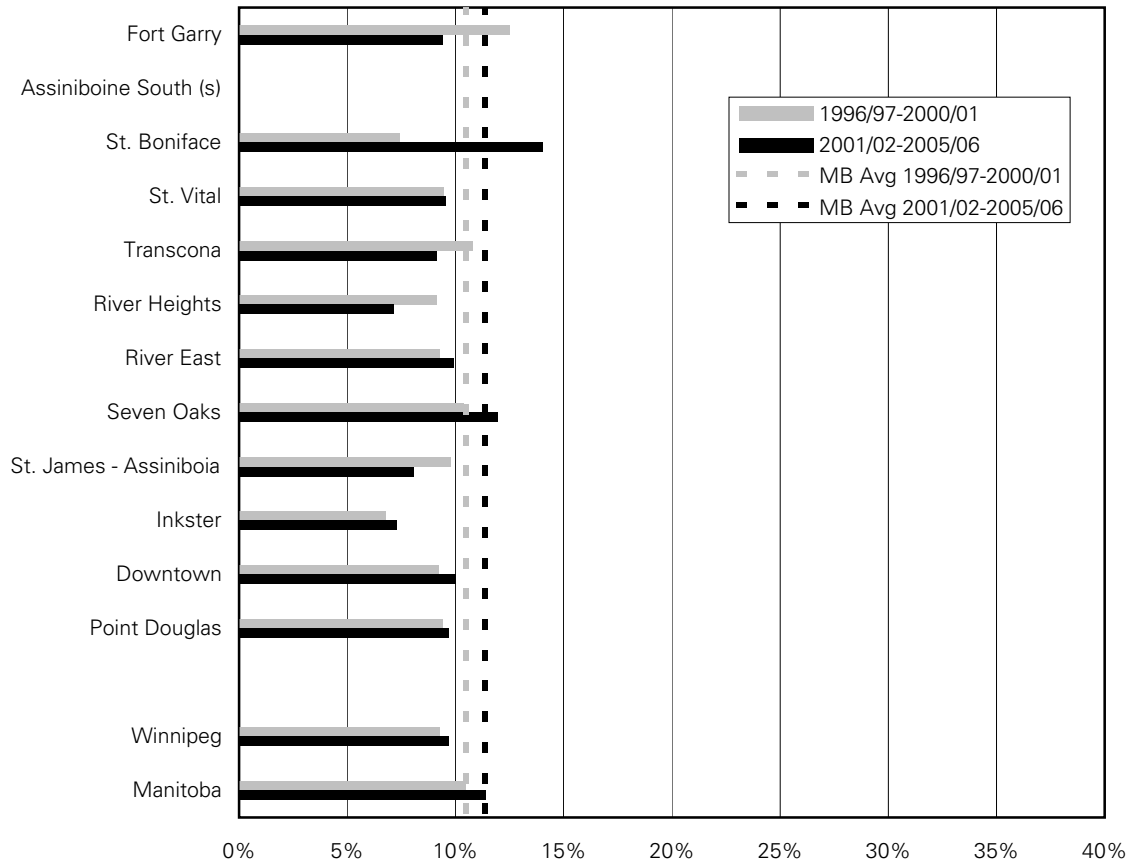
