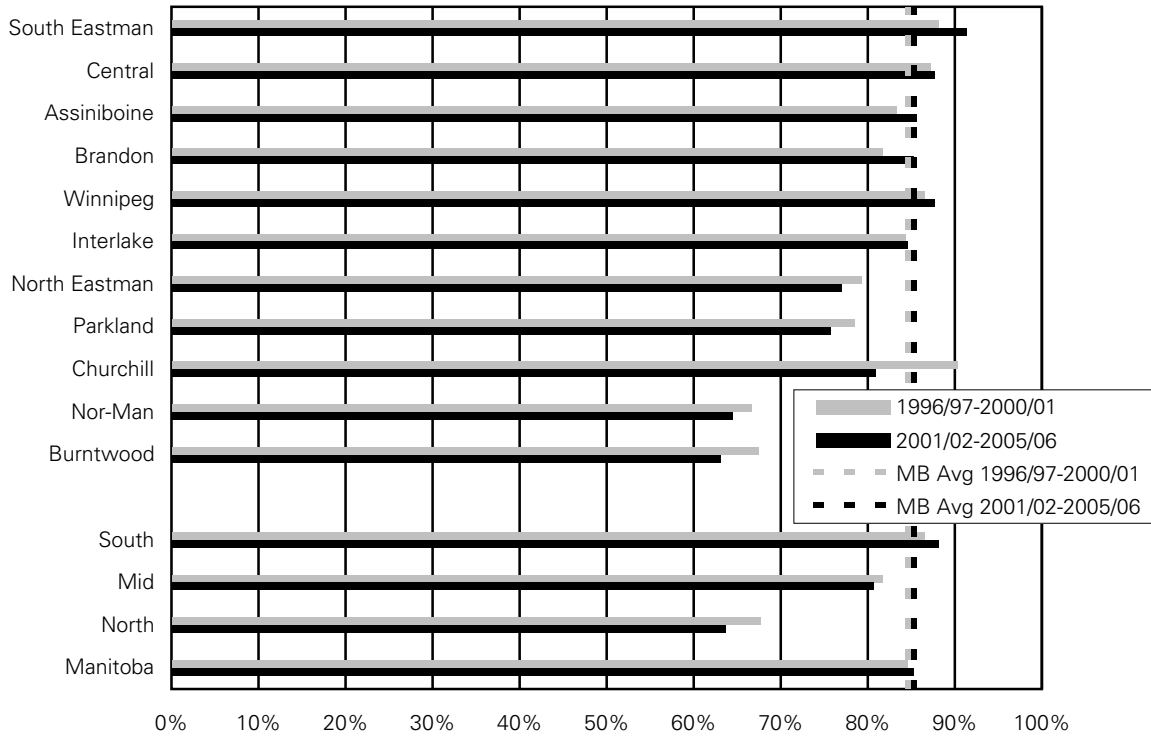


Figure A.3.64: Breastfeeding Initiation Rates for Ages 30+ Years by RHA

'2' indicates area's rate was statistically different from Manitoba average in second time period

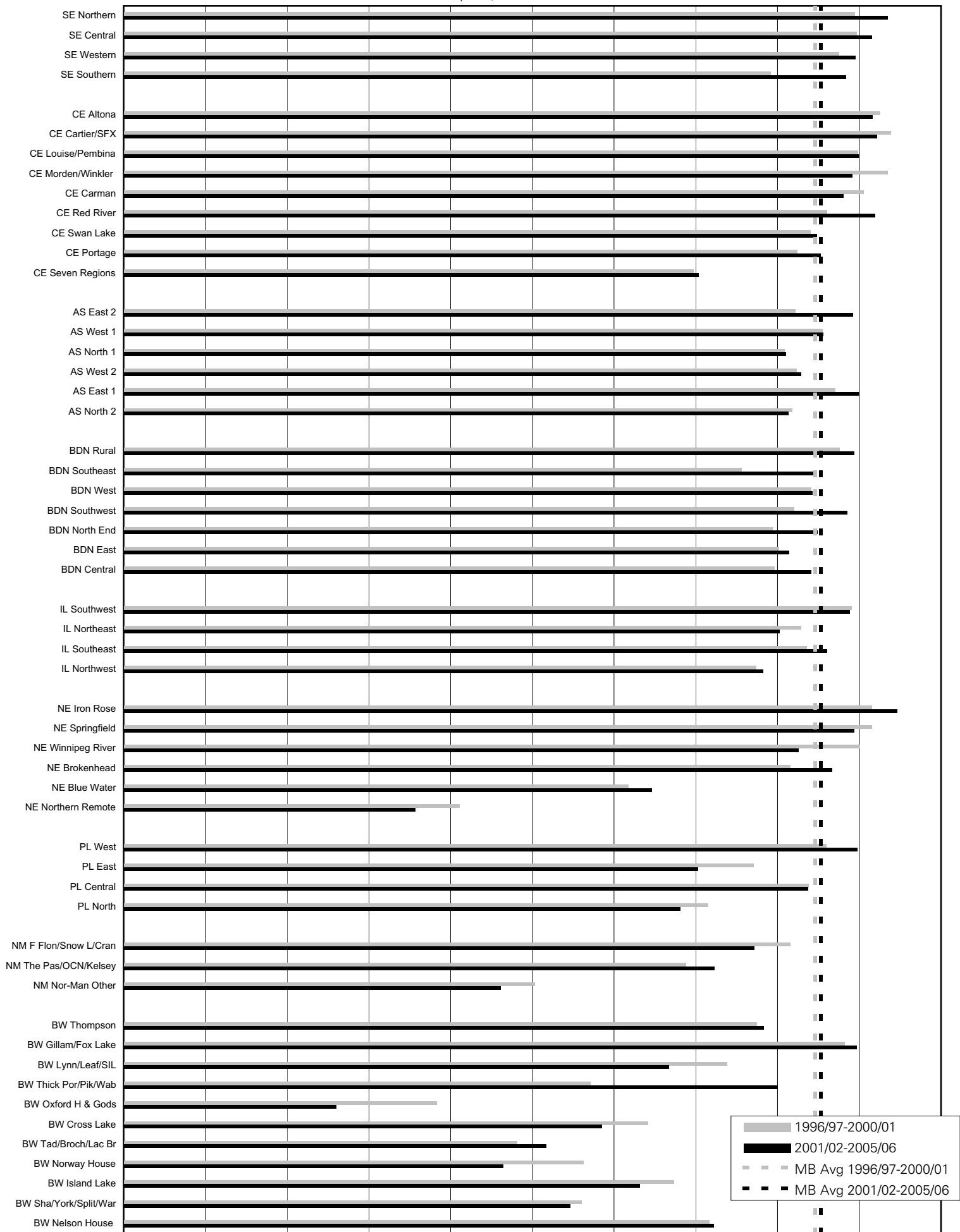

Figure A.3.65: Breastfeeding Initiation Rates for Ages 30+ Years by District

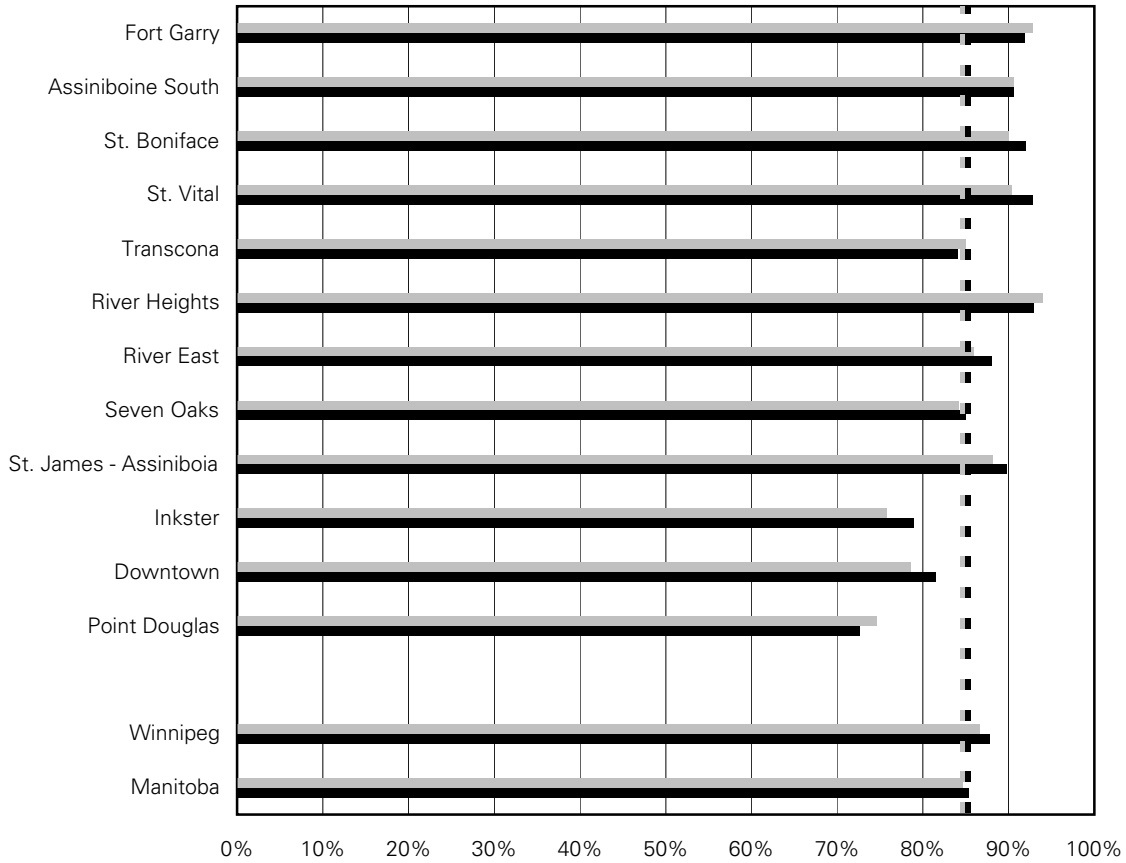

Crude rates per 1,000 women



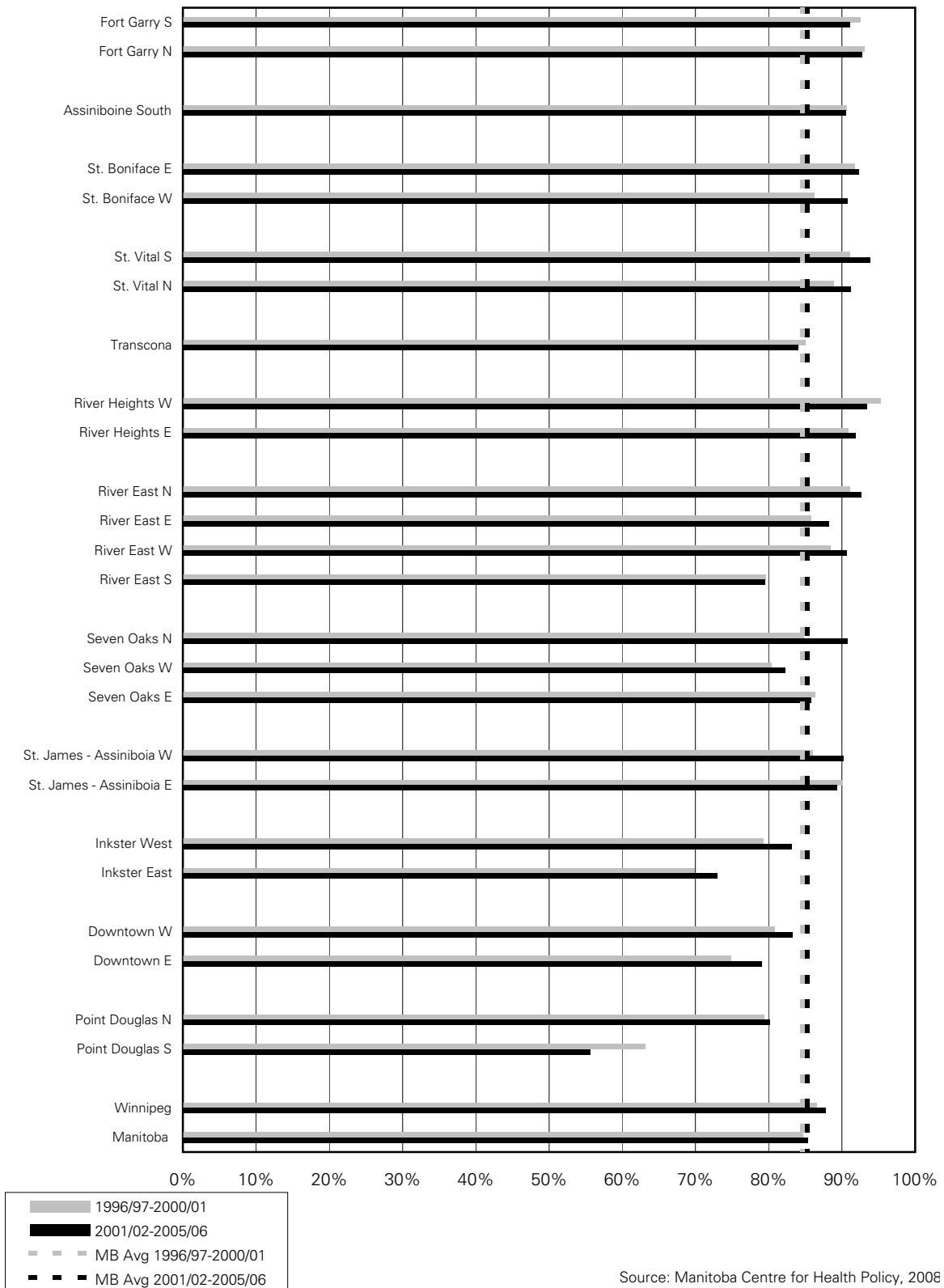

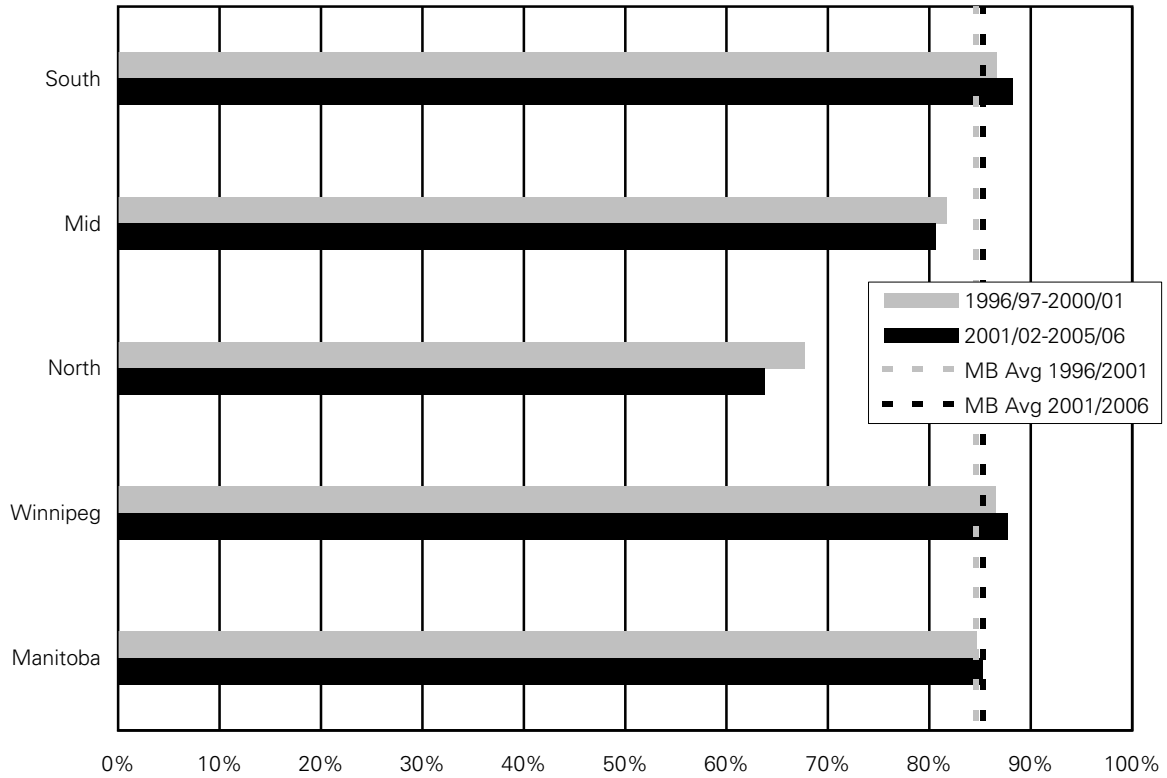
