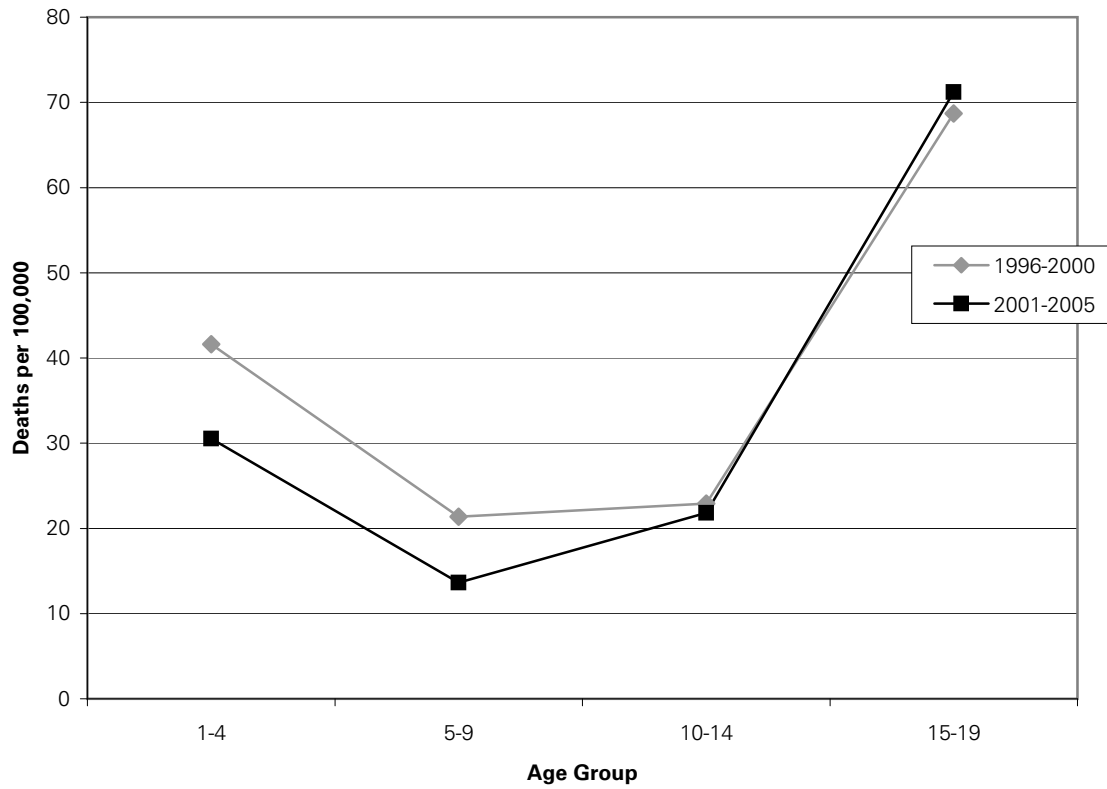


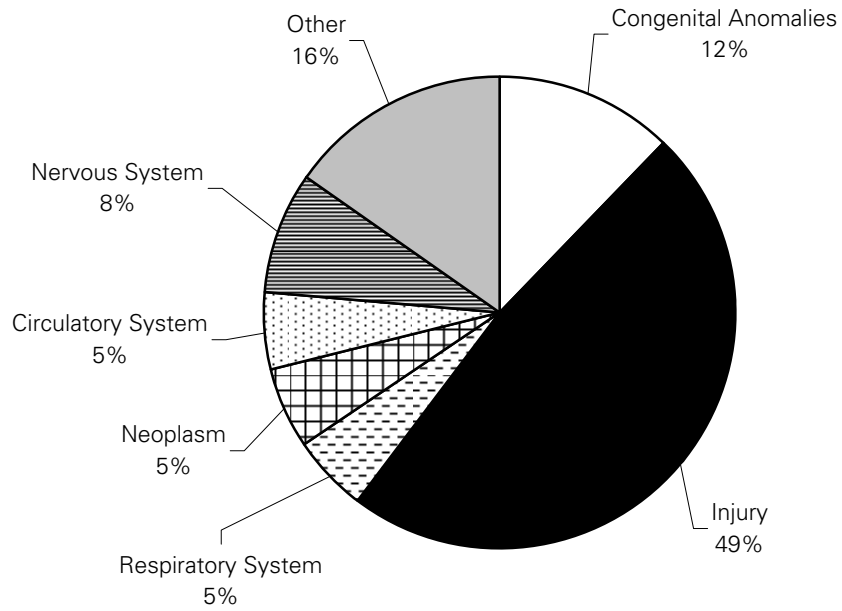
**Figure A.4.17: Child Mortality Rates by Age Group and Time Period**

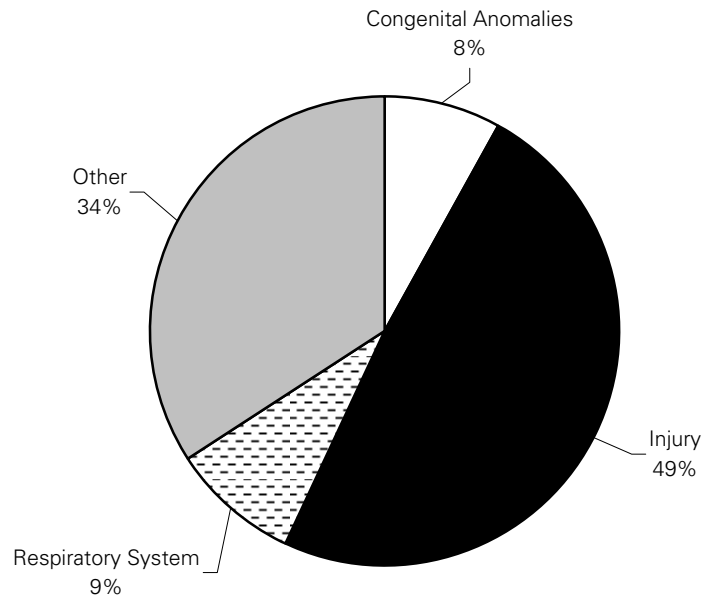
**Figure A.4.18: Causes of Death, Manitoba Children Aged 1-4 Years**

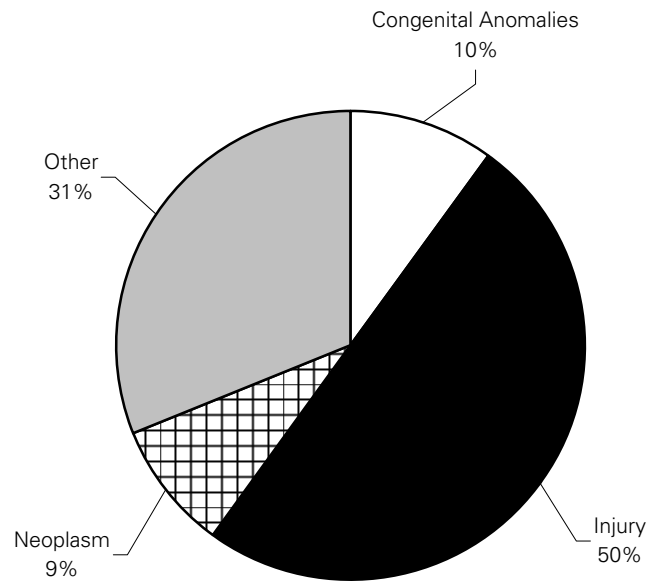
**Figure A.4.19: Causes of Death, Manitoba Children Aged 1-4 Years

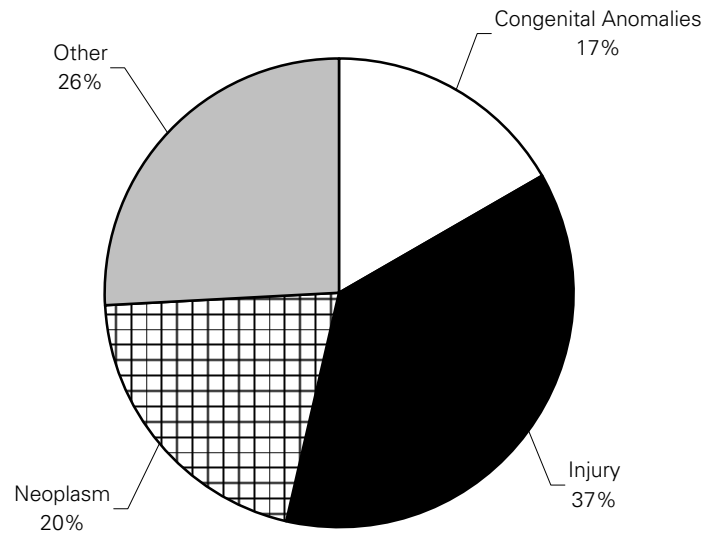
**Figure A.4.20: Causes of Death, Manitoba Children Aged 5-9 Years

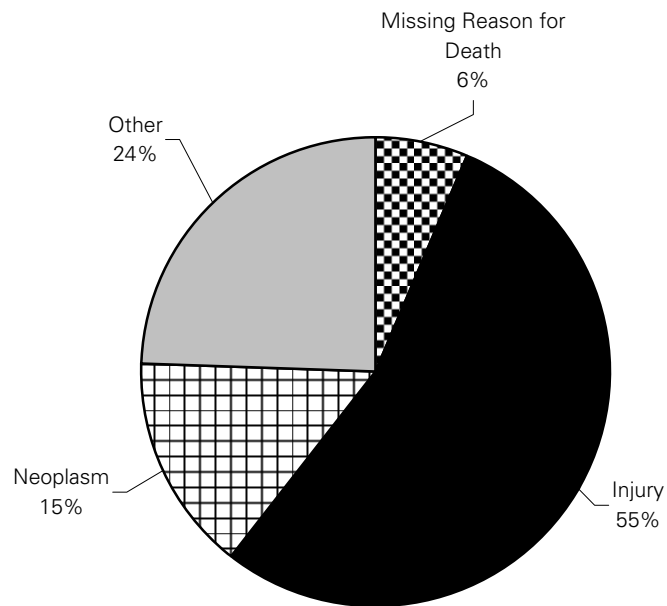
**Figure A.4.21: Causes of Death, Manitoba Children Aged 5-9 Years

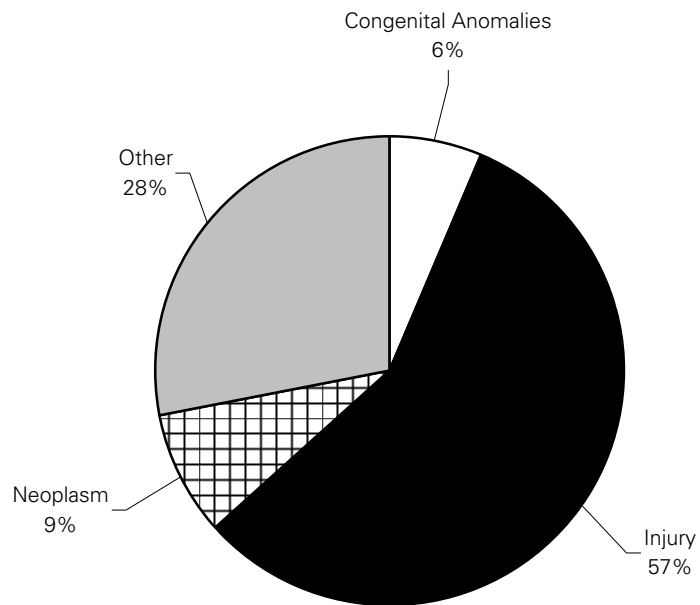
**Figure A.4.22: Causes of Death, Manitoba Children Aged 10-14 Years

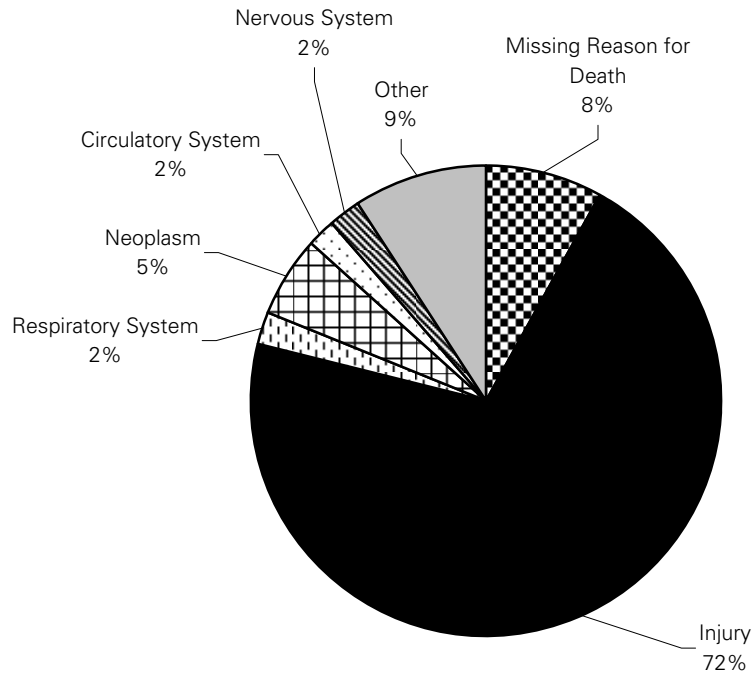
**Figure A.4.23: Causes of Death, Manitoba Children Aged 10-14 Years

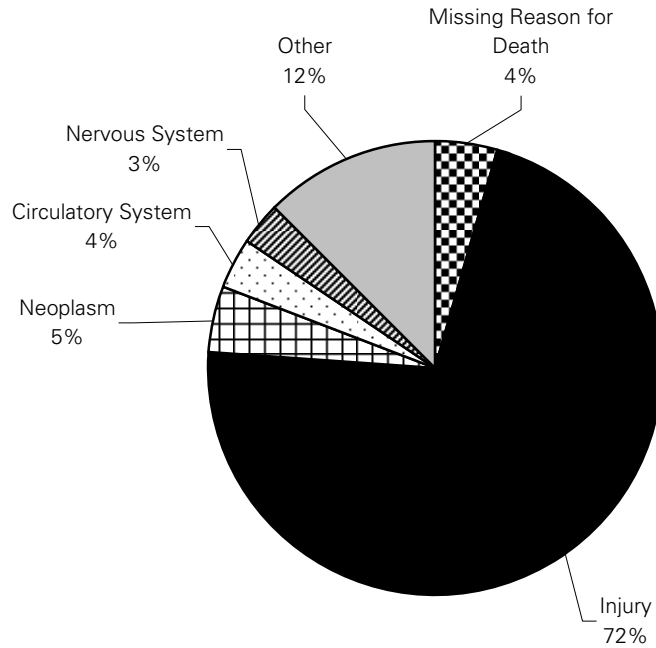
**Figure A.4.24: Causes of Death, Manitoba Children Aged 15-19 Years
