(Wind Instrument)**

Criteria:

- has completed at least the second year of study in the Faculty of Music at the University of Manitoba;
- must enrol full-time in the performance stream in the next consecutive year of study;
- has achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.5;
- has shown aptitude for and demonstrated ability on a wind instrument.

An endowment fund has been established at the University of Manitoba in memory of Jessica Marie Bernardin. Jessica was studying flute in the Faculty of Music at the University of Manitoba at the time of her death in November 2005. She was involved with both the University Orchestra and the Wind Ensemble. Not only a gifted flutist, Jessica excelled academically. She received a University of Manitoba Queen Elizabeth II Entrance Scholarship, achieved a Dean's Honour Roll standing in her first year of study and received a Richardson Scholarship in Music.

A scholarship, valued at the available annual interest, will be offered to a student who:

- has completed at least the second year of study in the Faculty of Music at the University of Manitoba and must enrol full-time in the performance stream in the next consecutive year of study;
- has achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.5;
- has shown aptitude for and demonstrated ability on a wind instrument.
- for 2006 only, the award will be offered to a student enrolled in the third year of study.
- For 2007 only, the award will be offered to a student enrolled in the fourth year Performance Stream on a classical wind instrument

The selection shall be named by the Dean of the Faculty of Music (or designate) and will include a flute professor.
