Eligibility: Music student

Criteria:

- enrolled in the Faculty of Music (including the Integrated Bachelor of Music/Bachelor of Education Program) either full-time or part-time at the University of Manitoba;
- has achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (or equivalent);
- has outlined their emergency situation during an interview with the Dean of the Faculty of Music.

With a gift of \$5,000.00 from Ada Bronstein, and a matching contribution from the Manitoba Scholarship and Bursary Initiative, an emergency bursary assistance fund of \$10,000.00 has been established at the University of Manitoba. The purpose of this fund is to provide immediate emergency bursaries to students in Music who are under unexpected financial strain. Beginning in 2006, the available annual interest will be offered to a student who:

- Is enrolled in the Faculty of Music (including the Integrated Bachelor of Music/Bachelor of Education Program) either full-time or part-time at the University of Manitoba;
- has achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (or equivalent);
- has outlined their emergency situation during an interview with the Dean of the Faculty of Music.

The selection of eligible student recipients shall be in accordance with the guidelines established from time to time for the University of Manitoba's student emergency bursary funds.
