

LEONARD HEATON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IN MUSIC

- Donor:** The late Mrs. Nellie Heaton in honour of her husband, Leonard Heaton
- Eligibility:** Music student
- Criteria:** registers as a full-time student in the Faculty of Music in the academic session immediately following upon the winning of the scholarship.
- Amount:** \$700.00

Under the terms of the Will of the late Mrs. Nellie Heaton, there has been established at The University of Manitoba a fund to support a scholarship award in memory of the Testatrix's husband, Leonard Heaton, who was for many years prominent in Winnipeg musical circles.

The scholarship shall be called the Leonard Heaton Memorial Scholarship in Music. It shall be awarded to a student who, having satisfactorily met the admission requirement to a degree program in the Faculty of Music at The University of Manitoba, registers as a full-time student in the Faculty of Music in the academic session immediately following upon the winning of the scholarship. In addition to meeting the admission requirements, the winner must give evidence acceptable to the selection committee of high ability in Music.

The selection committee shall be named by the Senate of The University of Manitoba and shall include the Dean of the Faculty of Music of The University of Manitoba or his/her representative.

If, for any reason, the winner of the scholarship does not register as required above, the scholarship shall be awarded by reversion to the next qualified candidate.

If in any year no student displays musical ability and achievement of sufficient merit to justify the award of this scholarship, the value of the award for that year shall be added to the capital of the fund.

The scholarship shall first be awarded in 1968 for tenability in the 1968-69 academic session. It shall have a value in the first year of award of \$225.00 and thereafter an annual value of \$300.00. The amount of the award shall be re-considered within five years and if the state of the fund permits, increased by \$25.00 or a multiple thereof. Beginning in 1984, the scholarship shall be increased to \$700.00.

The Board of Governors of The University of Manitoba has the power to modify the terms of this scholarship. Such modification shall conform as closely as possible to the expressed intention of the donor in establishing this award.
