

MARK NOZICK MEMORIAL MUSIC THERAPY SCHOLARSHIP

Donor: Ted and Deanna Cohen and the Manitoba Scholarship and Bursary Initiative

Eligibility: Music students pursuing further studies in the field of Music Therapy

Criteria:

- graduates from the Faculty of Music at The University of Manitoba with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5; and
- enrolls in a graduate or undergraduate programme at a university other than The University of Manitoba in the field of Music Therapy.
- The scholarship is renewable for one year upon successful completion of a full first year of the Music Therapy programme and receipt of proof of enrolment in the second year of the Music Therapy programme.
- If no eligible candidate is available in a given year, the scholarship will be offered to a student in the Faculty of Music at the University of Manitoba who is enrolled as a full-time student (at least 60 percent of a full-course load) in the final year of study in the Faculty of Music at The University of Manitoba

Ted and Deanna Cohen have established a fund at The University of Manitoba to encourage graduates from its Faculty of Music to pursue further music studies in the field of Music Therapy (currently not offered at The University of Manitoba). The Manitoba Scholarship and Bursary Initiative has made a contribution to this fund. This scholarship will be offered to a student who:

- graduates from the Faculty of Music at The University of Manitoba with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5; and
- enrolls in a graduate or undergraduate programme at a university other than The University of Manitoba in the field of Music Therapy.

The initial value of the scholarship will be \$500.00, which will be made available to the recipient upon receipt of proof of registration in the Music Therapy programme at the chosen university. The scholarship is renewable for one year upon successful completion of a full first year of the Music Therapy programme and receipt of proof of enrolment in the second year of the Music Therapy programme.

If no eligible candidate is available in a given year, the scholarship will be offered to a student in the Faculty of Music at The University of Manitoba who:

- is enrolled as a full-time student (at least 60 percent of a full course load) in the final year of study in the Faculty of Music at The University of Manitoba;
- has achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5; and
- indicates an intention to pursue further study in the field of Music Therapy.

In the event that a Music Therapy programme is established at The University of Manitoba, this scholarship will be offered solely to students who pursue study in this field at this University. The donors intend to review their financial commitment to this scholarship five years from its establishment.

The selection committee shall be named by the Dean of the Faculty of Music.
