



Dr. Kenneth Clark Travel Award in Nursing

Purpose

Dr. Kenneth Clark established an endowment fund at the University of Manitoba for the purpose to provide travel awards for nursing graduate students.

Eligibility Criteria

- (1) Are enrolled full-time or part-time in the Faculty of Graduate Studies, in any Master's or Doctoral program delivered by the College of Nursing;
- (2) Have achieved a minimum grade point average of 3.5 based on at least 12 credit hours of study at the Master's or Doctoral level;
- (3) Will be attending a professional conference to present the results of their graduate work (poster or oral presentation);
- (5) Applicants must be the first author
- (6) Have, in the opinion of the selection committee, demonstrated scholarship based on the submitted abstract and proposed knowledge dissemination.

Value

Please indicate amount requested in application. Value will be determined at the time of the selection and will be based on indicated need and number of applicants per funding year. Pending approval of recommendation of funding, funds will be sent by cheque to successful applicants.

Deadlines

At least 30 days prior to conference travel

Application Process

Applicants will be required to complete the online application form and submit/include the following information with their application at least 30 days prior to conference travel

1. Application form that outline details of travel and costs
2. A brief statement of their research (maximum 500 words)
3. A brief statement indicating what they hope to achieve through attendance at the conference (maximum 250 words)
4. A copy of the abstract submitted to the conference
5. Proof that the paper/poster has been accepted for presentation
6. A letter of support from their graduate advisor
7. Fill out and signed appropriate waiver form.

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Applicants will be notified within two weeks whether their application will be recommended for funding. Applicants who are being recommended for funding will be required to submit proof of conference attendance (e.g. certificate of attendance, conference badge, official conference program, agenda, or schedule-at-a-glance) within 30 days of the last conference date. Funds will be sent by cheque within 4-6 weeks following receipt of proof of conference attendance to the applicant.
