

Marguerite Hulme Scholarship in Pharmacy

DESCRIPTION

The Marguerite Hulme SCHOLARSHIP in Pharmacy is offered through the Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Manitoba.

Applicants are eligible for a Selection Committee Interview for this scholarship by filling out an application form (deadline: August 19).

Applicants must also include THREE (3) Letters of Reference; each is to be included with a completed application package and in their original, unopened, and sealed envelopes to:

Purpose of the Scholarship

In memory of his wife Marguerite, who graduated in Pharmacy from The University of Manitoba in 1940, Mr. G. Fred Hulme has established an endowment fund of \$300,000 at the University to support a Scholarship to encourage young women and men to enter the profession of Pharmacy.

The Scholarship, in the initial amount of \$3,000, shall be awarded annually, on application (see below), to a person who is a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident of Canada entering the first year of full-time studies (minimum 80% course load) in the Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Manitoba and based on the applicant's pre-pharmacy:

1. Academic record which shall be at an adjusted-grade-point average of not less than 4.0 and in good standing¹;
2. Participation in extracurricular activities; and
3. Demonstrated leadership potential

Scholarship Award:

The scholarship application acceptance period will occur in early fall, with the winner for a first year award being notified, in writing, in September. The scholarship is renewable annually through a reapplication process the deadline of which will be the month of June.

Selection of Scholarship Award Recipient(s):

The person(s) selected for the scholarship awards will be chosen by the Marguerite Hulme Scholarship selection committee as appointed by the Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy and which will normally be comprised of professors and pharmacists who serve students from the Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Manitoba in a multitude of settings.

Award Announcements:

Scholarship award winners will be notified by letter. Award winners will also be announced by news release and photograph on the Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Manitoba's website, in the weekly Manitoban newspaper, Alumni News and the Faculty's Newsletter and any other media, or event deemed appropriate by the Faculty of Pharmacy.

¹ Students are considered to be "in good standing" if they have obtained a minimum grade of 3.0 in each class.
