


Is considered a role model/mentor, demonstrating high standards of integrity and respect. (Max 250 words)

Builds relationships and community through developing respect, support, and trust. (Max 250 words)

Makes connections with Indigenous communities, groups, and organizations on and/or off campus. (Max 250 words)

The impact of the letter is not weighted by the status of the individual providing the letter, but more their ability to speak about the contributions the nominee has made.
