


**Demonstrates visionary thinking grounded in truth and courage that has resulted in advancing Indigenous engagement at the U of M. (Max 250 words)**

**Demonstrates leadership by example and is a role model. (Max 250 words)**

The impact of the letter is not weighted by the status of the individual providing the letter, but more their ability to speak about the contributions the nominee has made.
