- 1. Where program fees are used instead of per credit hour fees, the cost of tuition for the year is shown, unless otherwise stated. All figures exclude endowment fund contributions, student organization fees, fieldwork fees, material or equipment related fees.
- 2. Fees for Engineering represent those for years 2-5. Fees for Business represent those for years 2-4. Fees for Education represent all years of undergraduate education programs except for years 1-3 of NITEP, which is \$185 per credit hour. Fee per credit hour in Dental Hygiene is \$166; credit hours vary by year in program and therefore a range is shown. Fee per credit hour in Law is \$365; credit hours vary by year in program and therefore a range is shown. Tuition for Dentistry, Medicine, and Law is for the 2015-2016 entering cohort.
- 3. Effective Fall 2011, in addition to tuition fees, students in the Faculties of Business, Engineering, and Pharmacy pay Market Modifier Fees. Above fees for Business, Engineering, and Pharmacy include Market Modifier Fees. Both Law and Medicine include a \$4,546 program differential fee. Dentistry and Dental Hygiene fees include Clinical Operations Fees. Students seeking a degree in Dental Hygiene complete the Diploma program followed by one year in the Degree program. Effective Fall 2015, the Alberta Government implemented a tuition freeze for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 academic years.
- 4. The fee per course in the Faculty of Law is \$1,026. Effective Fall 2014, in addition to tuition fees, students in the Faculty of Business pay a Market Modifier Fee for most courses. Above fee for Business includes the Market Modifier Fee. Effective Fall 2015, the Alberta Government implemented a tuition freeze for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 academic years.
- 5. Students in the Agriculture Diploma program pay half the cost per credit unit. Fee shown is half the cost per credit unit for courses in the Agriculture Degree program. Tuition in the Faculty of Law is based on a 30 credit hour course load.
- 6. The Saskatchewan Collaborative Bachelor of Science in Nursing program (offered jointly by the Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science and Technology and the University of Regina) was new in Fall 2011. Effective Fall 2012, tuition is assessed based upon the faculty in which the student is registered.
- 7. The University of Western Ontario changed its name to Western University in 2012. Fees are assessed on a per course or program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Fee shown for Business is a program fee.
- 5. Fees are assessed on a per course or program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year).

 Many programs have different fees for new students and continuing students. In all cases, except Management, tuition shown is that of the 2015-2016 entering cohort. Tuition for Management reflects the fee paid by the continuing group as the entrance cohort pays the same fees as Arts during the first year of their program.
- 9. Students seeking a Degree in Dental Hygiene complete the Diploma program followed by one year in the Degree program. Engineering fee shown is without the auxiliary fee.
- 10. Pharmacy students must also pay a compulsory \$2,853 clinical fieldwork fee. Dental Hygiene Degree Program requires the prior completion of a Diploma in Dental Hygiene at an accredited institution. Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's programs and departments joined other academic units within the university. Students in Textile Sciences are now reported under Agriculture (Degree). Students in Family Social Sciences are now reported under Medicine. Students in Health Sciences/Health Studies are now reported under Health Sciences.
