- 1. Where program fees are used instead of per credit hour fees, the cost of tuition for the year is shown, unless otherwise stated. All figures exclude endowment fund contributions, student organization fees, fieldwork fees, material or equipment related fees.
- 2. Architecture fee represents Environmental Design program. Fees for Engineering represent those for years 2-5. Fees for Business represent those for years 2-4. Fees for Education represent all years of undergraduate education programs except for years 1-3 of NITEP, which is \$176 per credit hour. Fee per credit hour in Dental Hygiene is \$176; credit hours vary by year in program and therefore a range is shown. Fee per credit hour in Law is \$387; credit hours vary by year in program and therefore a range is shown.
- 3. Business, Engineering, and Pharmacy are assessed faculty-specific fees. Both Law and Medicine are assessed a \$4,546 program fee in addition to course fees. Dentistry and Dental Hygiene fees include Clinical Operations Fees. Students seeking a degree in Dental Hygiene complete the Diploma program followed by one year in the Degree program. Effective Fall 2015, the Alberta Government implemented a tuition freeze which remained in effect for the academic year reported.
- 4. The fee per course in the Faculty of Law is \$1,026. Effective Fall 2014, in addition to tuition fees, students in the Faculty of Business pay a Market Modifier Fee for most courses. Above fee for Business includes the Market Modifier Fee. Effective Fall 2015, the Alberta Government implemented a tuition freeze which remained in effect for the academic year reported.
- 5. Students in the Agriculture Diploma program pay half the cost per credit unit. Fee shown is half the cost per credit unit for courses in the Agriculture Degree program. Tuition in the Faculty of Law is based on a 30 credit hour course load.
- 6. Effective Fall 2012, tuition is assessed based upon the faculty in which the student is registered.
- 7. Fees are assessed on a program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Fee shown for Business is a program fee.
- 8. Fees are assessed on a program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Tuition for Management reflects the second year of study, as the first year of the program is assessed the same tuition rate as Arts. Effective 2016-2017 academic year, the Undergraduate program in Education has phased into a Graduate program.
- 9. Students seeking a degree in Dental Hygiene complete the Diploma program followed by one year in the Degree program. Engineering and Science fees shown are without auxiliary fees.
- 10. Represents the rate for Canadian and permanent residents. Continuing students, and residents of Newfoundland and Labrador, pay an undergraduate rate of \$85 per credit hour.
- 11. Pharmacy students must also pay a compulsory \$3,118 clinical fieldwork fee. Dental Hygiene Degree Program requires the prior completion of a Diploma in Dental Hygiene at an accredited institution.
- 12. The University of Manitoba is transitioning from a Bachelor of Science (Pharmacy) to a Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) degree program, with first intake Fall 2019. Students admitted Fall 2017 and earlier will complete the Bachelor of Science (Pharmacy) degree. PharmD programs are currently offered at the University of Alberta, University of Saskatchewan, University of Toronto, and Memorial University. The fees indicated above reflect what is assessed to students completing discontinued B.Sc. programs. Dalhousie University will introduce the PharmD program beginning Fall 2020.
