- 17. Postgraduate Medical Education students are physicians who have completed their undergraduate medical degree who are now registered in clinical residency programs.
- 18. The U of M offers selected courses, and the majority of fourth-year courses, for the University College of the North via distance education modalities. Enrolments reflect students registered in U of M courses only.
- 19. Decrease in enrolment in Pharmacy due to transition from B.Sc. Pharmacy to PharmD program, new in Fall Term 2019.
- 20. Increase due to introduction of Master of Human Rights, new in Fall Term 2019.
- 21. The Bachelor of Music (Music Education) new in 2019.
- 22. The University 1 program was introduced in 1998-99. Most "new" students, with limited or no university experience, have registered under this program.
