

**University of Manitoba**  
**Winter Term 2021 (as at March 1)**  
**Summary Report**  
**March 23, 2021**

**Important Note**

Similar to the Fall Term and as a result of the ongoing pandemic, most on-campus courses have continued delivery through remote-learning, with a small number of courses offered in person. These changes have varying effects on faculties, colleges, and schools, and will affect the comparability of some year-over-year figures.

In addition, Winter Term reports are typically updated after the March 1<sup>st</sup> reporting date. Because Winter Term 2021 started two weeks later than usual, an adjusted date of March 15 was used for the term.

**Winter Term Enrolment**

In Winter Term 2021, enrolment at the University of Manitoba increased by 3.4%. Total enrolment increased from 29,704 students in Winter Term 2020 to 30,700 students in Winter Term 2021.

Full-time enrolment increased by 0.6%, from 24,884 students in Winter Term 2020 to 25,033 students in Winter Term 2021. Part-time enrolment increased 17.6%, from 4,820 students to 5,667 students.

Undergraduate enrolment increased 4.0%, from 25,208 in Winter Term 2020 to 26,226 in Winter Term 2021. Graduate enrolment remained stable, with 3,764 students in Winter Term 2020 and 3,761 students in Winter Term 2021.

**Credit Hours**

Total undergraduate credit hours increased 3.5% from Winter Term 2020 to Winter Term 2021. Undergraduate credit hours in Winter Term 2020 were 259,506 and 268,632 in Winter Term 2021. Distance and Online Education credit hours, excluding remote-learning, decreased 1.7%, from 36,921 to 36,289.
