ii) Staff appointed on a full-time basis, whose term of appointment is less than one year.

(B) Staff members not included: Administrators (whether classified as academic or not), such as the president, vice-presidents, etc.; librarians; post-doctoral fellows; graduate teaching assistants; markers, demonstrators, lab assistants, etc.; academic staff who have been hired as researchers rather than teachers; and support staff.

(C) Instructors are excluded from this analysis.

2. Gender identity options were expanded in 2018. The category "another" includes those who selected a gender identity other than male or female, and those who chose not to disclose an identity.

4. Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's programs and departments joined other academic units within the university. Textile Sciences is now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences. Family Social Sciences is now reported under the Max Rady College of Medicine. Health Sciences/Health Studies are now reported under the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.

5. The Asper School of Business was formerly reported as the Faculty of Management.

6. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.

The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.

7. The Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences in 2016.

8. For comparative purposes, figures for the School of Dental Hygiene are included in Dentistry.

9. The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.

10. For comparative purposes, figures for the College of Rehabilitation Sciences are included in Medicine.

11. The College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine in 2016.

12. "Others" includes heads of affiliated colleges and institutes.

13. Excluded teaching staff are not included in counts and are defined by Statistics Canada to include:

(a) Religious and other staff paid according to salary scales lower than those applying to lay staff.

(b) Staff on leave without pay.

(c) Visiting staff.

(d) Deans and Directors.
