 3. An asterisk (*) indicates that the number of credit hours were below 100 in either year. Changes in faculties containing fewer than 100 credit hours can show abnormally large differences, therefore these are not reported.
 4. Effective Fall Term 2014, the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences. Totals are not comparable; therefore, percentage changes are not shown.
 5. The Department of Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering changed its name to the Department of Mechanical Engineering in 2013.
 6. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Faculty of Health Sciences. The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty. Totals are not comparable for the College of Medicine and the College of Rehabilitation Sciences; therefore, percentage changes are not shown.
 7. The decrease in credit hours is due to a restructuring of the credit hours assigned to courses.
 8. The Department of Physiology changed its name to the Department of Physiology and Pathophysiology in 2014.
