- 4. Effective Fall Term 2014, the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences. Totals are not comparable; therefore, percent changes are not shown.
- 5. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Faculty of Health Sciences.

  The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
- 6. Credit hours for Respiratory Therapy were reported under the Faculty of Medicine (School of Medical Rehabilitation) in Summer Term 2014.
- 7. Effective July 1, 2015 the Faculty of Human Ecology closed and its departments joined other academic units within the university. For Summer Term 2015, credit hours in these departments are reflected in Human Ecology.
