Notes:

- 1. Undergraduate Student Credit Hours (UGSCH) are the hours of weight associated with a course indicating the relative weight of the course in the program of studies. There is often a correlation between lecture class hours and hours of credit; for example, a full course carrying six (6) hours of credit may entail three (3) hours of lectures per week, both terms. This report includes:
 - (a) all distance education credit hours, including Independent Study, on-line courses, and group-based study;
 - (b) all courses taught off-campus with stipend from other than faculty, college, or school resources.
 - This report excludes:
 - (c) credit hours declared as "Challenge for Credit";
 - (d) 6000-level courses associated with graduate programs.
- 2. Credit hour totals reflect combined Fall Term and Winter Term activity, as at November 1 and March 1 respectively.
 - Winter Term 2017 used an adjusted date of March 15, as that term began two weeks later than usual.
 - Due to rounding, some totals may not match the sum of the individual department, or faculty/college/school, figures.
- 3. Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's courses and departments joined other academic units within the university.
 Textile Sciences is now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences, within Biosystems Engineering. Family Social Sciences is now reported under the Max Rady College of Medicine, within Community Health Sciences. Core Human Ecology and Health Program, Interdisciplinary are now reported under the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences, as Interdisciplinary Health.
- 4. Select courses previously associated with the Department of Biosystems Engineering have been reassigned to the Department of Engineering. Comparisons to previous reports should be made with caution.
- Effective July 1, 2017, the Department of Food Science and the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences merged into the Department of Food and Human Nutritional Sciences.
- 6. The Department of English, Film, and Theatre changed its name to the Department of English, Theatre, Film & Media in 2018.
- 7. The Department of Sociology changed its name to the Department of Sociology and Criminology in 2018.
- 8. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.

 The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty. Comparisons with previous years should be made with caution for the Max Rady College of Medicine and the College of Rehabilitation Sciences.
- 9. The Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences in 2016.
- 10. The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.
- 11. The College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine in 2016.
- 12. The Department of Physiology changed its name to the Department of Physiology and Pathophysiology in 2014.
- 13. Includes credit hours from the accelerated program run during the summer term.
- 14. Effective Fall Term 2015, the College of Nursing has two intakes for the Bachelor of Nursing Program one in Fall Term and another in Winter Term. In addition, Nursing revised its curriculum in 2015. As a result, credit hour comparisons should be made with caution.
