University of Manitoba Summer Term 2022 Overview

Introduction

As a result of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, comparisons to other years should be made with caution as figures may not be comparable.

Enrolments and credit hours in Summer Terms during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic were higher than pre-pandemic levels. In 2022, as pandemic restrictions have eased, enrolments and credit hours have decreased to levels slightly below pre-pandemic levels.

Overall

Total enrolment decreased from 12,170 students registered in Summer Term 2021 to 10,189 students registered in Summer Term 2022. Undergraduate enrolment decreased from 11,286 students in Summer Term 2021 to 9,328 students in Summer Term 2022. Graduate enrolment decreased from 884 students last summer to 861 students in Summer Term 2022.

Total undergraduate student credit hours decreased from 68,278 credit hours in Summer Term 2021 to 54,649 credit hours in Summer Term 2022.

Trend

Summer Term 2022 represents a 4.2% decrease in enrolment, compared to 2018, with 10,632 students in Summer Term 2018 and 10,189 students in Summer Term 2022.

Undergraduate credit hours represent a 7.0% decrease compared to Summer Term 2018, with 58,750 credit hours in Summer Term 2018 and 54,649 credit hours in Summer Term 2022.

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
