End of Course Change - Fall Term Enrolment

Summary Report

October 3, 2022

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, comparisons to other years should be made with caution as figures may not be comparable. Enrolments and credit hours during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic were higher than pre-pandemic levels. In 2022, as pandemic restrictions have eased, enrolments and credit hours have returned to pre-pandemic levels.

Fall Term 2022 represents a 1.6% decrease in enrolment, compared to Fall Term 2019, with 30,319 students in Fall Term 2019 and 29,843 students in Fall Term 2022.

Undergraduate credit hours represent a 1.2% decrease compared to Fall Term 2019, with 277,668 credit hours in Fall Term 2019 and 274,360 credit hours in Fall Term 2022.

Fall Term Enrolment

As at End of Course Change, overall enrolment at the University of Manitoba decreased from 31,160 students in Fall Term 2021 to 29,843 students in Fall Term 2022. The decline in enrolment in Fall Term 2022 was due mainly to a decrease in the number of part-time students. Full-time enrolment decreased from 26,471 students to 26,114 students; part-time enrolment decreased from 4,689 students to 3,729 students.

Undergraduate enrolment decreased from 26,674 students in Fall Term 2021 to 25,379 students in Fall Term 2022. Graduate enrolment decreased from 3,794 students last year to 3,780 students this year.

Total undergraduate credit hours decreased from 282,978 credit hours in Fall Term 2021 to 274,360 credit hours in Fall Term 2022. Distance and Online Education credit hours, excluding remote-learning, increased from 33,261 to 35,310 credit hours in Fall Term 2022.

Overall, international enrolment decreased from 6,796 students last year to 6,618 students this year. As at End of Course Change, international students make up 22.2% of the overall student population.

As at End of Course Change, the number of self-declared Canadian Indigenous students decreased from 2,632 students in Fall Term 2021 to 2,566 students in Fall Term 2022. Indigenous students make up 8.6% of the overall student population.
