- 1. Fees shown represent tuition paid by Canadian students. Where program fees are used instead of per credit hour fees, the cost of tuition for the year is shown, unless otherwise stated. All figures exclude endowment fund contributions, student organization fees, fieldwork fees, material or equipment related fees.
- 2. Architecture fee represents Environmental Design program. Fees for Engineering represent those for years 2-5. Fees for Business represent those for years 2-4. Fees for Education represent all years of undergraduate education programs except for years 1-3 of NITEP, which is \$191 per credit hour. Fee per credit hour in Dental Hygiene is \$191; credit hours vary by year in program and therefore a range is shown. Fees per credit hour in Law and PharmD are \$419 and \$456, respectively; credit hours vary by year in program and therefore a range is shown.
- 3. Business, Engineering, and Pharmacy are assessed faculty-specific fees. Both Law and Medicine are assessed a program fee in addition to course fees: Law \$8,143, Medicine \$5,569. Dentistry and Dental Hygiene fees include Clinical Operations Fees.
- 4. Business and Engineering are assessed faculty-specific fees. The fee per course in the Faculty of Law is \$1,257.
- 5. Students in the Agriculture Diploma program pay half the cost per credit unit. Fee shown is half the cost per credit unit for courses in the Agriculture Degree program. Tuition in the Faculty of Law is based on a 30 credit hour course load. Dentistry represents program fee paid by out-of-province students.
- 6. Effective Fall 2012, tuition is assessed based upon the faculty in which the student is registered.
- 7. Fees are assessed on a program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Fee shown for Business is a program fee.
- 8. Fees are assessed on a program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Tuition for Management reflects the second year of study, as the first year of the program is assessed the same tuition rate as Arts.
- 9. Engineering and Science fees shown are without auxiliary fees. Students seeking a degree in Dental Hygiene complete the Diploma program followed by one year in the Degree program. The BSc (Pharmacy) program is being phased out in lieu of the PharmD program; the last class to enter the BSc (Pharm) program was in Fall 2019. Fee per credit hour in PharmD is \$493; credit hours vary by year in program and therefore a range is shown.
- 10. Continuing students, and Residents of Newfoundland and Labrador pay the same undergraduate rate as Canadian and permanent residents. Pharm.D annual domestic student tuition is comprised of a base tuition by credit hour and a clinicial tuition fee. Program course credit hours vary each semester of the program and therefore a range is shown.
- 11. PharmD program introduced Fall 2019. Pharmacy students must also pay a compulsory \$3,600 clinical fee. Dental Hygiene Degree Program requires the prior completion of a Diploma in Dental Hygiene at an accredited institution.
