University of Manitoba Summer Term 2023 Overview

Total enrolment in Summer Term 2023 increased by 11.5%, compared to the previous Summer Term. There were 10,189 students registered in Summer Term 2022 and 11,363 students registered in Summer Term 2023.

Undergraduate enrolment increased from 9,328 students in Summer Term 2022 to 10,464 students in Summer Term 2023, an increase of 12.2%. Graduate enrolment increased by 38 students, or 4.4%, from 861 students last summer to 899 students in Summer Term 2023.

Total undergraduate student credit hours increased 22.4%, from 54,649 credit hours in Summer Term 2022 to 66,918 credit hours in Summer Term 2023. Credit Hours offered through Distance and Online Education were up 1.0%, from 19,203 to 19,398 credit hours in Summer Term 2023.

Enrolment and credit hour increases are due partly to the Bachelor of Nursing moving to three intakes per year and to a three-term program delivery model. Excluding Nursing, undergraduate enrolments and credit hours would have increased 8.0% and 9.9% respectively.
