## **DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRY – CODI Elective**

The CODI Outreach Program is a comprehensive program provided with a multidisciplinary team that involves a close working relationship with psychiatrist(s), nurse(s), social worker(s) and occupational therapist(s). The service provides both inpatient and outpatient care with the former taking place on a 20-bed inpatient unit. Each student will be responsible for approximately three inpatients, as well as being required to attend outpatient clinics which occur on Mondays from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. Attending the off-site MINE (methadone maintenance) clinics as well as outreach visits with case managers are also strongly recommended.

Students will be required to attend twice-weekly Kardex meetings (Monday and Thursday at 9:30 a.m.), as well as being encouraged to attend cross-service rounds. On Thursdays at 12:45 p.m. there will be clinical Case Presentation. On Tuesdays, students will be expected to attend Grand Rounds, 10:30 to 12:00pm and CODI Team Conference at 1:30-3:30 p.m. On Wednesday at 10:30-12:30 pm students will observe and may co-facilitate Dialectical Behavior Group Therapy.

## **Goals and Objectives:**

On completion of the elective, the student should be able to:

- 1. To learn to assess patients with regard to both mental disorders and substance use disorders.
- 2. To become aware of treatment and management pathways for patients with mental disorders and substance use disorders, separately and together.
- 3. To become aware of case management indications and processes for patients with substance use disorders and severe mental disorders.
- 4. To become conversant with psychotherapy options and processes for patients with co-occurring mental disorders and substance use disorders.
- 5. To become conversant with community and hospital resources for patients with mental disorders and substance use disorders, separately and together.

Call Responsibility: Call is NOT required

Availability: All year, variable length of time from a minimum of two weeks to a maximum of four weeks.
