Customized inpatient and/or Outpatient Experience

- 1. Inpatient Component:
 - 20 23 inpatient beds
 - Three staff Psychiatrists
- 2. Outpatient Component:
 - 4 outpatient follow-up clinics per week
 - 4 clinics per week where residents are assessing new patients in the presence of the staff psychiatrist and other trainees. Students would have the option of doing some of these assessments.
 - 3 staff psychiatrists, 2 residents, 3 nurse therapists, 1 social worker, 1 occupational therapist.
- 3. Weekly program rounds.
- 4. Weekly cross program rounds.

- 1. How to take a psychiatric history.
- 2. How to develop a management plan.
- 3. Interviewing skills.
- 4. How to interact with members of a multidisciplinary team.
