

Master of Music Advisory Committee Appointment Form

Each graduate student is provided with an Advisory Committee. The Advisor (Chair) of the committee must be a full-time faculty member and a member of the Faculty of Graduate Studies. The Advisor discusses with their graduate students the appropriate members of faculty to recommend to the Associate Dean for appointment to the Advisory Committee. This Advisory Committee helps to guide student course selection and content and serves to evaluate the final thesis/practicum. This form should be submitted to the Graduate Program Assistant early in the first term of the student's first year of graduate study when potential advisors have indicated their willingness to serve on the Advisory Committee for a particular student.
