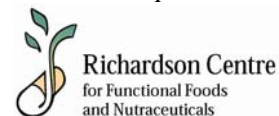
### \*\*\*NOTE TO GRADUATE STUDENTS AND TRAINEES PRESENTING ABSTRACTS
