



Background

At their ten-year reunion in 2014, the Pharmacy Class of 2004, along with friends and other supporters, raised initial funds totaling \$10,000 to establish an endowment fund at the University of Manitoba.

The scholarship fund was created in memory of classmates Lisa Gibson (nee Nichol) (d. 2013) and Pak-Wai Chan (d. 2014), to act as a lasting testament of their support of pharmacy students, the profession, and their fellow classmates.

The donor provided an additional gift of \$225 in 2015, which was combined with the available annual income from the fund to offer the first scholarship in the 2015-2016 academic session.

Eligibility

College of pharmacy undergraduate students.

Submission deadline

May 30 annually

Criteria

Each year, the available annual income from the fund will be used to offer one scholarship to an undergraduate student who:

- Is enrolled full-time (minimum 80% course load) in the second year or higher of the degree program in the College of Pharmacy at the University of Manitoba
- Has achieved a minimum degree grade point average of 3.5
- Has demonstrated leadership qualities and extra-curricular involvement
