

EU ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

INTERNATIONAL CREDIT MOBILITY (ICM) FUNDING

Erasmus+ offers the opportunity for higher education institutions to send and receive students, faculty and staff abroad to study, teach, or train at participating European institutions.

1) STUDENT EXCHANGE SCHOLARSHIPS

- Support undergraduate and graduate students participating in a current UM exchange program with selected European partner institutions
- The study period abroad must be part of the student's study program to complete their degree and requires course work unless otherwise specified

Duration: 3 to 12 months

Financial Support:

Living Expenses - up to 900 Euro (Approx. 1,350 CDN\$) per month

Travel Expenses - 820 Euro (Approx. 1,230 CDN\$)

2) FACULTY/STAFF EXCHANGE TRAVEL GRANTS

FACULTY TEACHING EXCHANGES

- Individual grants for faculty members to support short- term teaching exchanges with selected European partner universities

FACULTY/STAFF TRAINING EXCHANGES

- Individual grants for faculty and non-academic staff
- Supports professional development opportunities with selected partner universities
- Activities may include: professional staff development, partnership development and monitoring of agreements, exchange of best practices, job shadowing, observation periods and training at a partner institution

Duration: minimum 5 days to maximum 2 months (varies depending on the partner institution)

Financial Support:

Living Expenses - Per Diem up to 180 Euro (Approx. 270 CDN\$) per day, including travel days

Travel Expenses - 820 Euro (Approx. 1,230 CDN\$)
