JEAN MONNET FUNDING

Provides opportunities for teaching, research, and policy debate relevant to the European Union Higher Education Institutions (HEI) established in any country of the world may apply

- Designed to promote excellence in teaching/research in European Union studies worldwide
- Foster dialogue between the academic world and policy-makers, including enhancing EU policies
- Key activities may be implemented at University of Manitoba with/without EU partners
- May include courses, research, conferences, networking activities, and publications

Jean Monnet Modules	40 hour teaching programme at the applicant institution	30,000	3 years
Jean Monnet Chairs	90 hour teaching programme and at least one other activity at the applicant institution	50,000	3 years
Jean Monnet Centres of Excellence	Coordinate resources on EU studies; lead research activities; develop teaching content and tools; enhance exchange about the EU; publish research results	100,000	3 years
Jean Monnet Networks	Exchange knowledge and expertise; Gather/promote information and results; enhance cooperation; create high knowledge exchange platform <i>(Minimum 3 partners from 3 countries required)</i>	300,000	3 years
Jean Monnet Projects	Innovation (explore new angles, methodologies); Cross-fertilization (promote discussion, reflection on issues and enhance knowledge); Spread content	60,000	12-24 months
Support to Associations	Publicize information about the EU among the public. Applicants must be an officially registered association with legal status and may be established in any country.	50,000	3 years

*Grants cover up to 75 to 80 percent of the total cost of a project depending on the Action
