

## Assessment Grid for Tier 2 CRCs at the University of Manitoba

1. Evidence of excellence as an emerging world-class researcher demonstrating research creativity and the potential for national/international leadership in their field as demonstrated by their accomplishments including, but not limited to: support for traditional knowledge or Indigenous ways of knowing; advances to equity, diversity, inclusion and accessibility in the research ecosystem; meaningful sharing of research to communities and groups; community services leveraging academic expertise; communication of research results across a wide variety of audiences; contributions to policies, laws, regulations, guidelines; publication of reviews/reports, book chapters, peer-reviewed papers, professional papers; refereed presentations; receipt of competitive research funding. **30 points**
2. Evidence of originality and creativity in the the proposed research program. **25 points**
3. Evidence of the likelihood of or demonstrated record of attracting, developing, and building capacity of excellent trainees, students (at all levels), and postdoctoral fellows (and continued potential to attract and develop). **15 points**
4. Evidence of the ability to develop research partnerships and collaborations, including community partnerships, and nurture collaborative research teams within and outside the faculty and university. **15 points**
5. Evidence of impact of the researcher in their field including, but not limited to, peer recognition (awards/honours from professional societies), visiting professorships, invitation from communities to partner/collaborate, national and international invited lectures. **10 points**
6. Degree of alignment with the Faculty's and University's strategic research plans. **5 points**

Total is 100 points.
