UM SAFE APP


UM Safe is an essential tool that sends safety alerts and provides instant access to campus safety resources. The app includes features such as "Work Alone" and "FriendWalk", as well as a Mobile BlueLight feature similar to the stationary blue lights on our campuses.

Some of the app features involve interaction with Security Services, and some will be optional — while other features have no interaction with Security Services.

Used by hundreds of higher education institutions and millions of people around the globe, the app was developed by App Armor and is custom branded for the U of M.

The free mobile safety app for students, staff, and faculty is available for iPhone (App Store) and Android (Play Store) devices.

The Mobile BlueLight button will only contact Security Services when the person is within the campus Safe Walk boundaries. If outside of the Safe Walk boundaries, the Mobile BlueLight notification will go to 911.



Do you buy, sell or trade items online? It's a good way to:

- » Rid yourself of unused items.
- » Save a few dollars buying items you do need.
- » Help the environment by reusing items that may otherwise end up in a landfill.

Remember as always, caution is key in preventing yourself from being victimized.

There are Buy and Sell Exchange Zones located at each of the four Winnipeg Police Service Stations Use these locations to conduct legal buy and sell transactions.



Tips for completing your transactions safely:

- space.
- » Do not meet someone alone.
- » Ask for a photo of the serial number before meeting and attempt to confirm the item hasn't been reported stolen.
- » Don't provide your personal information to anyone.
- Take screenshots of the advertisement and ID number, the sellers contact information and all communications.
- » Know who you are dealing with. Check the buyer's/seller's name through an online search engine.
- » Take only enough cash with you to pay for the item you are purchasing.
- » Ask about the history of the item being sold.
- » Do not provide payment until you receive the item.
- » Do not give out your personal or banking information.
- » Use generic photos when posting an item for sale.
- » Trust your instincts! If something feels wrong it probably is.

SUSPICIOUS

It is essential that the university community is comfortable and feels safe when spending time on campus. Security Services responds to reports of suspicious people and vehicles on campus.

Responded to 83 Suspicious Calls

Safe Walk/Safe Ride

Safe Walk and Safe Ride is a free service in which Security Services staff will meet and walk you or give you a ride to/from your car, class, residence room, or bus stop. If you do not feel comfortable walking on campus, Security Services would be happy to assist you. 60 Safe Walks and 27 Safe Rides Completed

Medical Emergencies

Security Services responds to all medical emergencies on campus. Sometimes Security Services staff are the first to respond to an emergency. They also play a key role in guiding the emergency responders to the correct building and room. 12 Medical Emergencies

Access

Alarms

Everyday Security Services helps students and staff who want access to buildings or rooms. Security Services staff must alter daily operations to assist with unscheduled door openings. 180 Unscheduled Access Requests

Security Services respond to all safety and security alarms on campus, for example, Fire, Code Blue, Elevator, Emergency Phones and Panic Alarms.
