BACKGROUND

The Wyrzykowski Family Scholarship awards 4 scholarships of \$5,000 each. Mr. Conrad Wyrzykowski, Sr. established this scholarship to encourage greater understanding of humanity through travel, service learning, and field research experiences.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

The criteria for eligibility are:

- Current undergraduate student member of St. Paul's College at time of application.*
- Fulltime, undergraduate student enrolled in courses offered by the Catholic Studies Minor program **And/Or** courses that involve ongoing field research connected to the Near Eastern Biblical Archaeology Laboratory (NEBAL) at the University of Manitoba.
- Applicants must have completed at least 3 credit hours of Catholic Studies in BA Minor program; as well as, completed a travel study course from a credited and recognized University (preference for travel courses offered by the Catholic Studies BA Minor program at the University of Manitoba) **OR** a service learning program recognized by St. Paul's College, **OR** courses that involved field research connect to NEBAL.
- Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Applicants must submit a 1000 word essay highlighting their travel study course, service learning experience, or field research experiences with the completed application form.
- Demonstrated participation within St. Paul's College or greater community in an area of interest to the College with supporting references of applicant's participation.
- **Students will receive their award at the St. Paul's Day Award Ceremony in January.**

*All University of Manitoba students are welcome to apply and to become members of the College by requesting their preference for membership via the Aurora system. Membership fee is \$19 per term.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The application must be received by the Dean of Studies prior to or on **September 30**, to receive consideration. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be extended until 4:30 p.m. the next business day.
