The **Susan Deane International Paulinian Award** is awarded to students on the basis of the following criteria:

- membership at St. Paul's College at time of application\*
- graduated from the ICM transfer program
- enrollment as a full-time undergraduate student at the University of Manitoba
- have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- demonstrate active participation within the College and/or community in an area of interest to St. Paul's College and/or directly associated with St. Paul's College
- attached current Aurora transcript
  - This scholarship is awarded in January at the St. Paul's Day Awards Ceremony.

## APPLICATION DEADLINE

The application must be received in the Dean's Office prior to or on **September 30** to receive consideration. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be extended until 4:30 p.m. the next business day.
