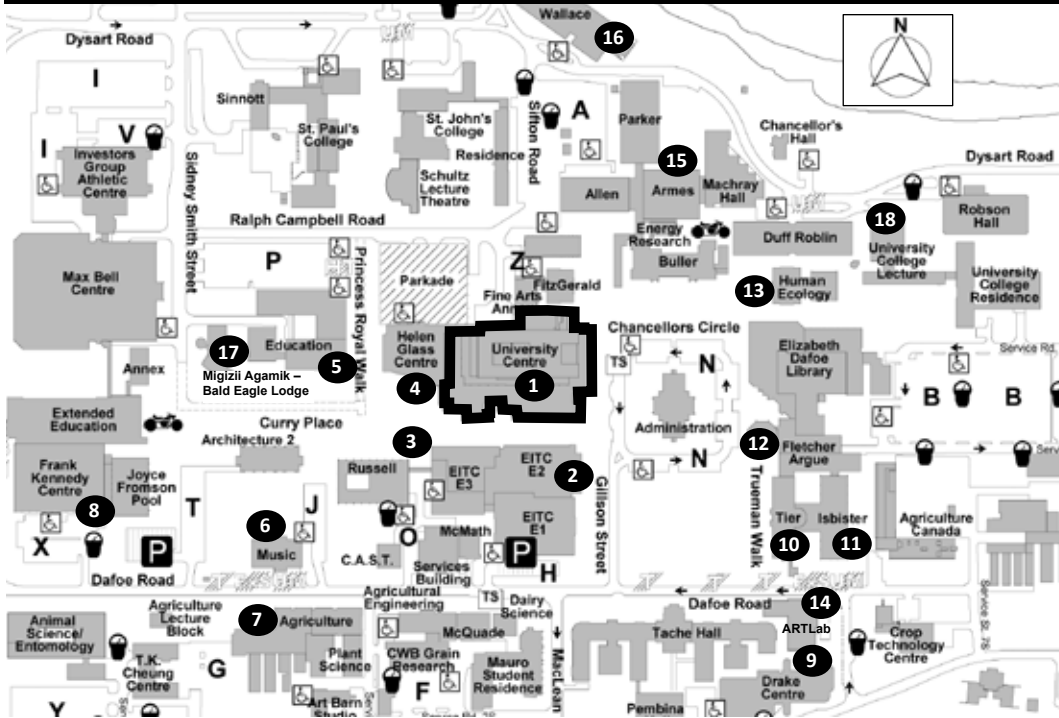

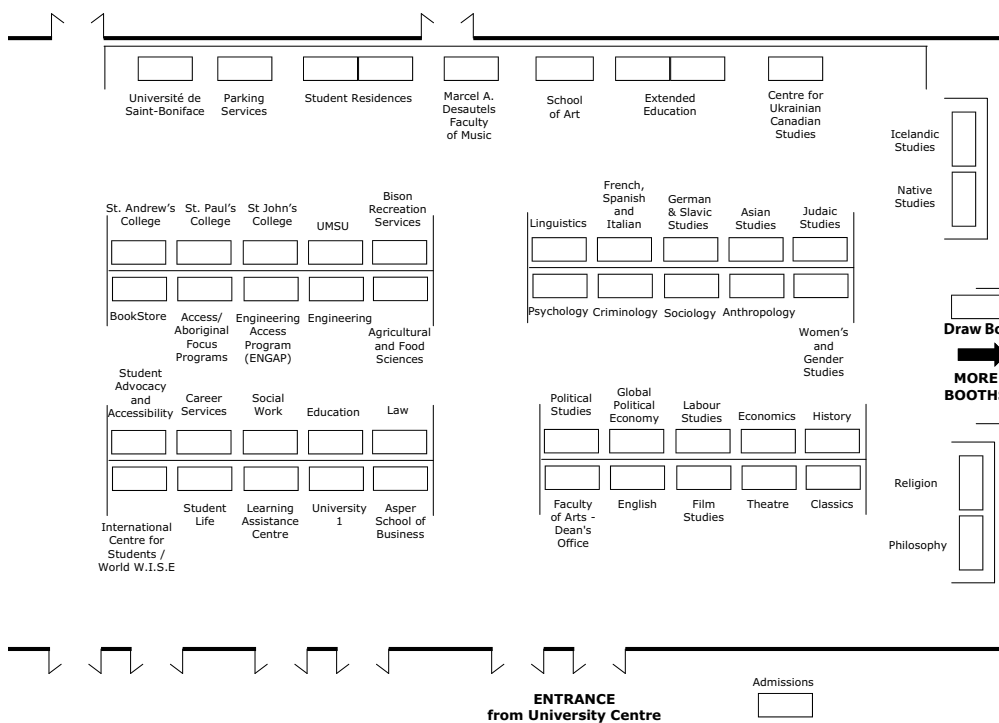


INFO VILLAGE

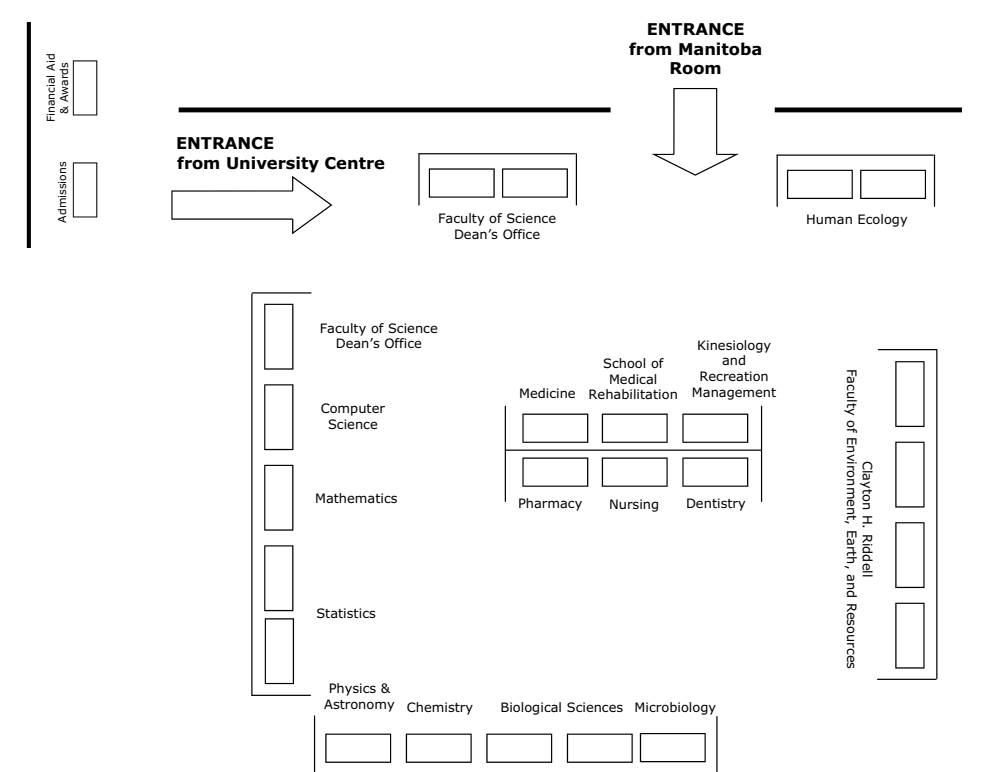

COUNSELLOR'S LOUNGE

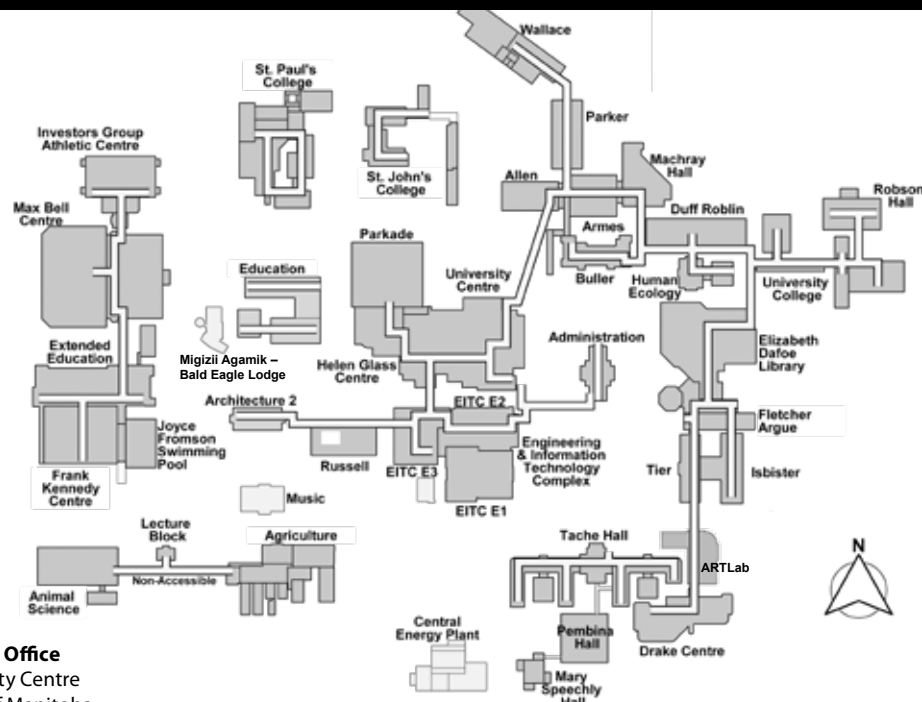
