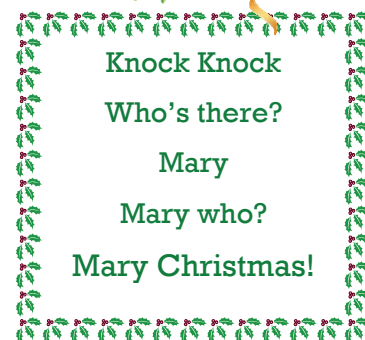
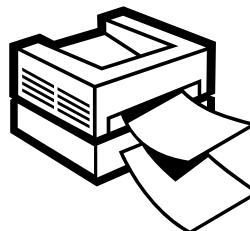


Reminders

If you are interested in improving your writing, notetaking, time management, and exam study skills consider attending the Learning Assistance Centre workshops. Workshops are scheduled throughout the Fall and Winter Terms. Writing tutors are also available. You can either make an appointment or contact a writing tutor online. Workshops and appointments with tutors are **free** for University of Manitoba students (students are limited to two appointments per week).

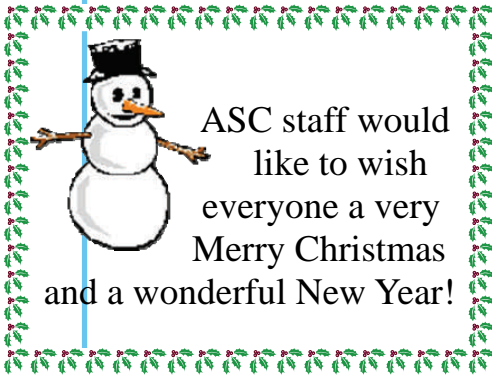
