## Updates from UM

The Security Services Department is pleased to announce the launch of a new mobile safety app called UM Safe.

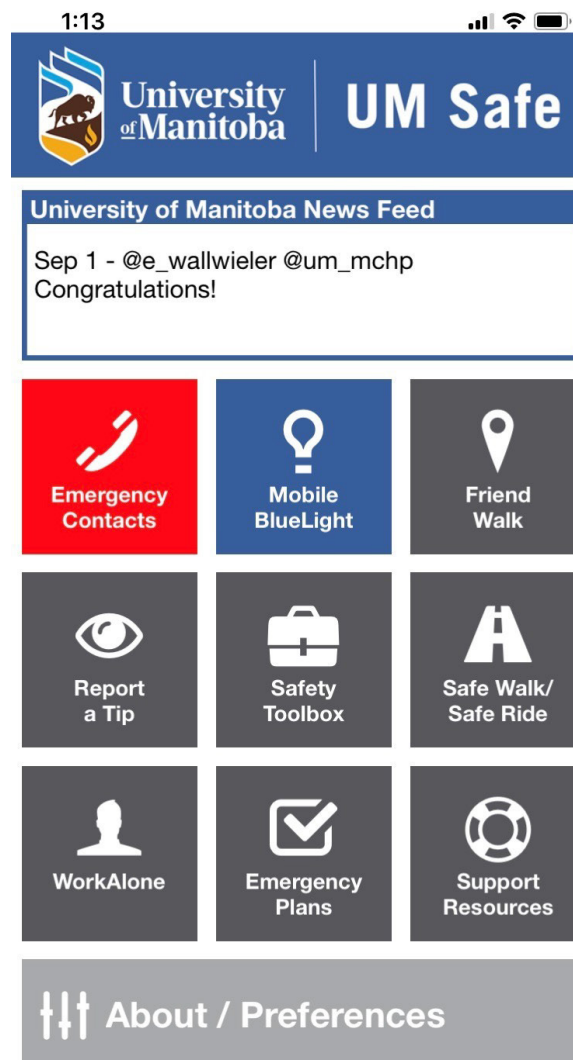
## Safety App UM Safe

- Mobile BlueLight
- Friend Walk
- Safe Walk / Safe Ride
- Report a Tip
- Support Resources



It's important to note that some of the app features will involve interaction with Security Services, some will be optional while others will have no interaction with Security Services. As an example, the Mobile BlueLight will only contact Security Services when the person is within the campus Safe Walk boundaries. If the person is outside of the Safe Walk boundaries, the Mobile BlueLight notification will go to 911.
