Lisa Delplace will illustrate the firm's design aesthetic, highlighting that no matter the size or application, the same design principles apply: effective use of positive and negative space, form and scale, light and shadow, and texture. The lecture will feature a series of built case studies that highlight how OvS uses design principles to establish a garden's architectural foundation and to capitalize on seasonality and time.

Lisa E. Delplace, CEO and Principal of Oehme, van Sweden & Associates, has been practicing landscape architecture for 30 years. Her extensive knowledge of ecological processes and deep commitment to their artistic execution result in a strong sculptural relationship between landscape and architecture. She has applied this design philosophy in developing designs for commercial, institutional, and private developments, as well as pioneering innovative rooftop terraces, green roofs, and vertical green walls for clients nationwide. Ms. Delplace has served as an international lecturer for distinguished universities and professional organizations. She received a Masters of Landscape Architecture from the University of Michigan.
