Dear Incoming Master of Landscape Architecture Student:

We are delighted to welcome you to the Department of Landscape Architecture.

We are making arrangements for the new academic year and ask you to note that all Master Students must register online. Access for registration in the Faculty of Graduate Studies will begin on July 20, 2023. Registration will be confirmed through your <u>Aurora Account</u>. However, all Master of Landscape Architecture students must contact the Graduate Student Advisor, Tobi Hawkins, before registering.

During the registration period, detailed information will appear on the syllabus section of the class schedule and provide you with the course essentials, technological requirements, and expectations and needs regarding the format of each course you are registering for. Please note that the **Drawing Workshop as part of LARC 7110 LA Studio 1** will start in person on **Monday, August 28, 2023.** All other classes resume in person on **Wednesday, September 6, 2023.** I also encourage you to check the University's <u>Coronavirus website</u> for more information and updates on safety protocols and prevention measures.

You should register before September 2023 for your fees to be set. The registration revision period finishes on September 20. The deadline for paying fees (to avoid late fees) will be announced on the Registrar's Office website.
