
The following resources will help get you started with your course selection and registration, degree planning and orientation information for the Faculty of Arts at the University of Manitoba.

DEGREE PLANNING AND CHOOSING COURSES

Degree Planning in Arts—Learn about the different degree options and over 40 major and minor choices.



- First Year Planning Guide—Online guide for first year students to learn course planning basics including:
 - > how to determine your course load (how many classes you choose to take or need to take to fulfill funding/ scholarship requirements)
 - > which courses to select to help you get a good start on your degree and major of choice
 - > how to select courses and build a timetable
 - > how and when to register for courses (using Aurora system)

COURSE REGISTRATION

Aurora Student Registration System—Online system where you register for UM courses. Prepare in advance by viewing instructions, tutorials and important dates.



AFTER REGISTRATION

UM Achieve—Online degree audit tool that provides you with degree progression information and "what-if" scenarios to compare different options. This tool is useful throughout your degree. Once you register for classes, go into UM Achieve to see where your courses fit into your degree requirements (e.g. "W" requirement, "M" requirement, humanities requirements, etc.)
