
The Asper School of Business Career Development Centre conducted a survey of the MBA graduating classes of October 2018, February and May 2019. This is a summary of the results. Out of a class of 49 students, 43 graduates responded to the survey = **88% of the graduates responded to the survey**. The statistics were calculated using the information provided by those that responded.

A survey of the Asper Master of Finance students class of 2018/2019 was conducted. Out of 17 graduating students, 7 responded to the survey = 41% of graduates responded to the survey.

A survey was conducted of the Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) graduating class of 2019. This is a summary of the results. Out of 383 graduating students, 283 students responded to the survey = **74% of the graduates responded to the survey**.

## **ASPER GRADUATING MBA CLASS OF 2019**




### EMPLOYMENT OF MBA GRADUATES BY CONCENTRATION







Percentage of F-T employed graduates










### EMPLOYMENT OF BCOMM (HONS) GRADUATES BY INDUSTRY

Number of F-T employed graduates


