## WHAT IS AN ASPER GRADUATE STUDENT MENTOR?

You will act as an adviser, motivator and role model to our Asper MBA, Master of Finance, and Master of Supply Chain students as they look to enhance their careers, make a career change or familiarize themselves with a new region.

Through the mentoring experience, our students are looking for guidance and feedback on developing their leadership skills, information on industries or career paths and insight to best business practices.

As a mentor, you will have the opportunity to either meet with a student mentee on a one-to-one basis (five times over an eight month period) or choose to host a one-time group mentoring session for students interested in your company or area of specialization.

## WHAT IS EXPECTED OF ME AS A MENTOR?

The program is designed to be flexible, allowing you and your student mentee to decide on how best the relationship will work.

The minimal expectations of our mentors are:

- Approach the mentoring relationship with an open mind, professionalism and respect.
- For one-to-one mentors, strive to meet with your student mentee five times over an eight month period. For group mentors, host a small group of students once.
- Guide your student mentee toward achieving developmental and career goals by providing constructive feedback.
- Share knowledge about specific jobs, career paths, leadership competencies, organizational cultures and industries while facilitating networking opportunities.
- Communicate concerns immediately.

As a mentor, you are NOT expected to offer jobs or internships, to have all the answers, or to initiate contact with your student mentee.

The student you mentor will benefit greatly from your expertise. This partnership will also be a positive and enriching experience for our mentors. We hope each mentor will:

- Experience a (re)connection with Asper.
- Feel inspired and re-energized through their connection with students.
