PROGRAM COSTS

Fees for Canadian citizens and Permanent Residents (subject to change):

Fees will vary depending on how long a student takes to complete the program. Total Canadian tuition is \$35,000 (\$575 per credit hour), with an estimated \$2,000 of additional annual fees.

The total cost for textbooks in the degree is an estimated \$3,000.

A Tuition Sponsorship Application Form will be required prior to the fee payment deadline.
