*****IMPORTANT INFORMATION re: Curriculum and Instruction (C&I) Courses**

**Registration in C&I 4000 level course is dependent on the Major & Minor Subject.
It is VERY Important to check that each C&I course is taken in the correct year and term.**

Some students will be registered for both C&I 4000 level courses in year 1 (Winter Term).

These students will register for one of the 3000 level Cross Stream Courses (EDUA 3000 or EDUA 3002) in Year 1 and will take the remaining two Cross Stream Courses in Year 2.

Some students will be registered for one C&I 4000 level courses in year 1 (Winter Term) and one C&I 4000 level course in year 2 (Fall Term). These students will register for two Cross Stream Courses in Year 1 (EDUA 3000 & EDUA 3002) and one Cross Stream course (EDUA 4000) in year 2.

Some Students will be registered for both C&I 4000 level courses in year 2 (Fall Term). These students will register for two Cross Stream Courses in Year 1 (EDUA 3000 & EDUA 3002) and one Education Elective in year 1.

Withdrawing from/Deleting courses

Some courses are offered in one particular term only and unlikely to be offered in Summer Session. Some courses are only offered in alternate years. **It is important to take note of pre and co-requisites prior to withdrawing or deleting a course.** You should contact an Academic Advisor to consult on how withdrawing/dropping courses may affect your graduation date or your continuation in the program.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

New and currently registered students will be sent registration information in June of each year. The information will specify which courses B.Ed. Staff will register the student in and provide guidance on which courses students are responsible to register for themselves. Students should take particular care in ensuring they are aware of and register for ALL pre-requisite and co-requisite courses. Students who VW from a course must ensure they also VW from the co and pre requisite courses. Failure to do so may result in being removed from the associated required courses and delaying graduation from the B.Ed. program.

Students are also responsible for acquainting themselves with all VW and Fee Payment and Fee Refund deadline dates as specified in AURORA and/or the UM General Calendar or the appropriate UM websites.
