HELEN JANZEN MEMORIAL BURSARY

A bursary fund has been established at The University of Manitoba by the colleagues and friends of Helen Janzen (B.A./36, B.Sc.H.Ec./40, B.Ed./58), the first provincial supervisor of Home Economics in Manitoba's Department of Education. The Manitoba Scholarship and Bursary Initiative has made a contribution to this fund. The purpose of the fund is to provide bursary assistance to graduates of the Faculty of Human Ecology at the University of Manitoba who are pursuing studies in the two-year After-Degree Certificate Program in the Faculty of Education.

The available annual interest generated by the fund is to be offered each year as a bursary (initially to be valued at \$100) to a student who:

- (1) has completed a Bachelor of Human Ecology degree at the University of Manitoba;
- (2) has participated actively in school and community activities;
- (3) shows evidence of need as determined using the standard University of Manitoba bursary application;
- (4) enrolls in the two-year After-Degree Certificate program in the Faculty of Education.

The selection committee shall be named by the Dean of the Faculty of Education and shall include one member of the executive of the Manitoba Home Economics Teachers Association.
