Dr. J. M. Brown was Dean of the Faculty of Education from 1959 to 1974 and served on the staff of the Faculty from 1957 to 1974. Dean Brown was a man of many talents and was both teacher and mentor to the hundreds of students who graduated under his quiet and compassionate leadership.

- Has been identified as a superior mentor of student teachers either as a faculty supervisor or a cooperating teacher.
