ABOUT THE AWARDS

The Faculty of Education Alumni Association Excellence in Teaching Awards for Early, Middle and Senior Years Teachers were created to recognize the important work of teachers in Manitoba. Teachers do not necessarily need to be classroom teachers. Other areas such as resource, counseling, art, human ecology, music, and drama are also eligible.

AWARD CATEGORIES

Three awards will be given annually to teachers in each of the following categories: early years, middle years, and senior years.

NOMINATION DEADLINE

Nominations are welcomed immediately but must be submitted no later than July 31, 2024, to the Faculty of Education on behalf of the Education Alumni Association via email at communications.education@umanitoba.ca.

NOMINATION CRITERIA

Alumni Status: The nominee must be a graduate of the University of Manitoba, Faculty of Education in any of the following: Bachelor of Education, Post-Baccalaureate Diploma in Education, Master of Education and/or PhD in Education.

Current Employment: The nominee must currently be teaching in Manitoba.

Nominator Requirement: The nominee must be nominated by at least two people, one of whom must be an educator. Nominators may also be parents, community members, students, teacher candidates, or individuals in other applicable roles.

AWARD CRITERIA

The successful recipients of the Faculty of Education Alumni Association Excellence in Teaching Awards will have demonstrated one or more of the following characteristics:

- Teaching excellence
- Creativity and initiative
- Commitment to education
- Ongoing professional growth
- Positive contribution to teaching
- Introduction/implementation of new or pilot programs
