

# Hazardous Spill Clean-up

## BLOCK OFF AREA

Use signs, tape, chairs, or close doors to prevent others from coming into contact with the spill.

## GATHER SUPPLIES

Gather all the materials needed to clean the spill, such as your spill kit.

3



## PROTECT YOURSELF

Use any required PPE such as safety goggles and gloves.

## TREAT SPILL

Where applicable and appropriate, neutralize or treat the spill.

5



## COLLECT SPILLED MATERIALS

Use absorbents and/or a dustpan and broom to collect the spilled material.

## DISPOSE OF MATERIAL

Dispose of all contaminated materials in a leak-proof, puncture-resistant container. Glass and other sharps must be handled carefully using forceps or other tools to prevent cuts. Dispose of materials using the UM Waste Chart or contact EHSO for waste disposal instructions.

## DECONTAMINATE AREA

Rinse the spill area with water and wipe up. *Note: As some chemicals react with water, review the SDS and applicable safe work procedures prior to this step.*

8



## NOTIFY AND RESUME OPERATIONS

Return the area to regular working conditions and notify anyone necessary that they can resume their work.
